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OVERVIEW

Built as a bespoke 21-metre classic wooden motor-sailer in 1987 and currently lying in Split, Croatia, she is offered for sale at €545,000 (tax not paid). The interior comfortably accommodates up to 8 guests in four en suite cabins, arranged as two master staterooms and two double cabins, presenting a refined and private layout suited to both owners and charter clients.

Her dependable propulsion comes from a 205 HP Cummins engine, delivering a relaxed cruising speed of approximately 9 knots, while electrical autonomy is supported by twin generators (20 kVA + 15 kVA). Onboard systems include air conditioning and Wi-Fi, navigation equipment such as radar and GPS, and galley appliances comprising a refrigerator, dishwasher and deep freezer. With a 5.90 m beam, expansive deck areas and a charter optimised interior plan, this luxury motorsailer is equally well suited to private family cruising and Adriatic charter operations.

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

21 m motorsailor

Lying in Split, Croatia and flying the Croatian flag, this elegant 21.00 metre motorsailor is a classic wooden gulet custom-built in 1987 to a Custom Made specification, listed with make and model both as Custom/Custom Made, and distinguished by a traditional wooden displacement hull that confers the steady, seakindly manners expected of her type. Measuring 21.00 metres overall and on deck with a generous 5.90 metre beam and a variable draft of 2.00 metres minimum to 2.90 metres maximum, she comfortably cruises at approximately 9 knots under power from a single inboard Cummins engine rated at 205 HP; the brochure does note a documented discrepancy regarding fuel type, with the technical table indicating "Electric" while the descriptive section specifies the 205 HP diesel engine. Fuel is carried in one 1,800-litre tank and fresh water in a 4,000-litre tank, and electrical generation aboard is provided by two generators rated at 20 kVA and 15 kVA.

Configured for relaxed cruising and charter operations, she sleeps up to eight guests across four en-suite cabins arranged as two master cabins and two double cabins, supported by four guest heads and two crew heads to ensure smooth service. The interior and exterior guest spaces are roomy and thoughtfully arranged, and the ample beam makes extended stays aboard both comfortable and practical. Guest comfort and entertainment are well provided for with navigation and electronics including GPS and radar, along with a TV and onboard Wi-Fi; interior conveniences comprise a deep freezer, dishwasher, refrigerator and full air conditioning, and the vessel is equipped with the essential systems required for comfortable operation.

On deck, the vessel's traditional motorsailor lines are complemented by expansive lounging and al fresco dining areas, teak side decks, a boarding

gangway and convenient water access via a swimming ladder, features that enhance her appeal for private ownership or charter throughout the Adriatic. Construction and key particulars are consistent with her Custom Made 1987 build: a wooden displacement hull, type Motorsailor/Gulet, single Cummins 205 HP engine, cruising speed around 9 knots, 1,800 litres fuel capacity, 4,000 litres fresh water capacity, twin generators (20 kVA and 15 kVA), and her current location in Split, Croatia under the Croatian flag.

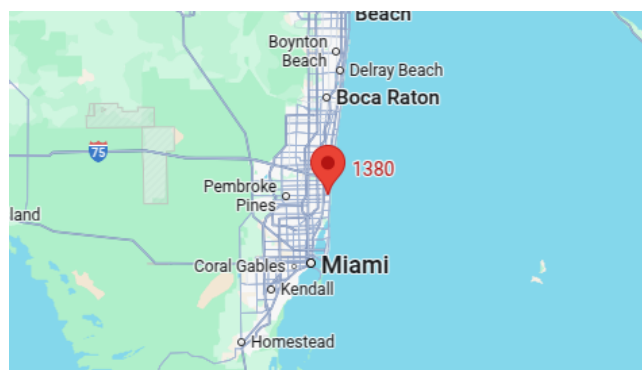
