OVERVIEW

HULL #4 Delivered May 2025

MCP Global Exp 68

Dreamed and engineered by MCP YACHTS' Damien Chaves and Manoel Chaves — two generations of seafarers and aluminum builders — the Global Exp 68 was born to be a sustainable, ocean capable yacht that brings cruisers comfort and security wherever their journeys lead. Conceived by TEAM MCP, this model marries the refinement, safety, and poise characteristic of an MCP Yacht with the indomitable spirit of an expedition sailing vessel. It is a genuine bluewater cruiser and a performance passagemaker, crafted for extended voyages without sacrificing elegance.

The hull is fashioned from 5083 aluminum alloy, Lloyd's Register certified, combining exceptional lightness with extraordinary strength. This metal structure is non flammable and non absorbent and, compared with heavier fiberglass alternatives, can be up to ten times stiffer. Weight is further reduced by intelligent joinery and low density composite elements, producing a lively, responsive sailing platform. Meticulous aluminum workmanship and considered material choices yield an explorer sailing yacht that prioritizes sustainability and safety while delivering a serene, first class onboard experience.

1 - Aft Cabin Master Stateroom

An expansive private retreat aft, the master stateroom offers a king size berth, a dedicated office nook, full height wardrobes, and a comfortable lounge sofa, all complemented by a luxuriously appointed, unusually generous bathroom that emphasizes both volume and comfort.

2 - Cockpit and Doghouse

The cockpit is centrally arranged to maximize the aft suite's living space and is

sheltered beneath a sculpted hardtop. A rigid doghouse replaces traditional canvas dodgers and biminis, removing the need for protective covers so the yacht presents immaculate lines and is always ready to set sail.

3 - Engine Room

A defining attribute is the fully enclosed, full height machinery space, accessed through a watertight door fitted with manual dogs and protected by aluminum watertight bulkheads. The space is lined with precise acoustic insulation rated to endure temperatures up to 600°C, and it is arranged for straightforward serviceability.

4 - Raised Salon and Pilothouse

The raised salon offers calm circulation in rough weather by incorporating a protected pilothouse within the main lounge. From here panoramic sea views unfold alongside integrated autopilot controls, navigation electronics, engine levers, and windlass controls, providing true offshore command and comfort.

5 - Swing Keel

A hydraulic, retractable swing keel runs along the centerline while occupying minimal interior volume. With the keel raised the draft is only 1.85 m, protecting propeller and rudder for confident approaches to anchorages. When deployed the keel system is mechanically, hydraulically, and structurally robust; in the event of impact the hydraulic circuit functions as an effective energy absorber.

6 - Electronics Technical Area

A ventilated, dedicated bay houses navigation systems, battery chargers, and monitoring equipment in an environment optimized for delicate electronics, ensuring reliable operation of critical systems.

7 - Midship Cabins

The raised salon layout creates distinctive midship guest suites with privileged waterline perspectives. These snug cabins provide comfortable double berths,

fold away sofas, plentiful storage, and en suite bathrooms, with ventilation through side portlights and large ocean hatches that double as emergency exits.

8 - Forward Cabin

The forward suite is generous enough to serve as a primary cabin on many yachts of this size, awash with natural light and featuring a large double berth, a settee, ample storage including a private closet, and a well scaled bathroom. Direct bow access leads into the forward technical space.

9 - Bow Technical Area

A purpose built workshop and tool storage area is situated forward, designed to support maintenance and shipboard projects and to foster true self sufficiency for expedition style sailing.



DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Overview

Equipped for confident bluewater passages and effortless daysails alike, this yacht presents a specification that reads like a wish list, delivering both seaworthiness and comfort in equal measure. The electronics suite provides absolute clarity and control from harbor to horizon, with a depthsounder, log-speedometer, wind speed and direction instruments, repeaters, a navigation center, autopilot, compass, GPS, VHF, radar, radar detector, computer, TV set, radio, and cockpit speakers, all arranged to keep the skipper informed and in command. A comprehensive sail wardrobe empowers performance across every breeze, comprising a fully battened mainsail, a battened mainsail, a furling mainsail, a genoa, a furling genoa, a storm jib, a spinnaker, a gennaker/cruising spinnaker, an asymmetric spinnaker, and a trisail, so the boat can be trimmed for speed, balance, or heavy-weather security at a moment's notice. On deck, precise handling is delivered by both a steering wheel and a tiller, supported by hydraulic and electric winches and a spinnaker pole to manage power with ease and finesse. Maneuverability and comfort continue below with a stern thruster and a bow thruster for assured docking, an electric bilge pump and a manual bilge pump for safety, a battery charger and an air compressor for systems support, and climate comforts including air conditioning, heating, and hot water. Long-range independence is reinforced by a fresh water maker and a sea water pump, while domestic conveniences such as a dishwasher, washing machine, oven, microwave oven, a marine head and an electric head, plus a refrigerator and a deep freezer ensure life aboard is as effortless as it is enjoyable. Reliable energy management is assured by a shore power inlet, a generator, and an inverter, and exterior refinements elevate life on deck with a teak cockpit and teak

sidedecks, a gangway and a hydraulic gangway, a wind generator and a solar panel, plush cockpit cushions surrounding a cockpit table, a swimming ladder and a cockpit shower, outboard engine brackets, davits, a radar reflector, a tender, and a liferaft. Protection and easy maintenance are equally comprehensive with a Bimini Top, a mainsail cover, a cockpit cover, a genoa cover, a spray hood, a lazy bag, and lazyjacks, making this yacht a turnkey solution for owners who demand capability, comfort, and style from harbor to horizon.

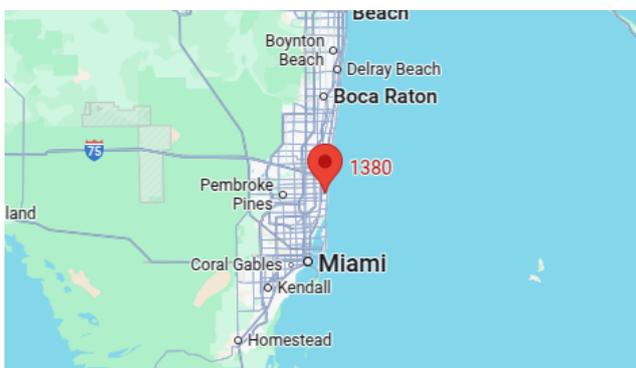
