


















DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Sails and rigging

A powerful aluminum mast rises over a Carbon Canoe Boom complete with integrated light and protective cover, setting the tone for effortless performance as the full batten square top mainsail of 207m² travels smoothly on traveler cars, cut for pace and control with upper battens supporting an ample roach to maximize usable sail area; precision foresail controls pair with a hydraulic furler for the staysail and a dedicated furling system for Code 0, while the mainsail is specified in D4 Grey Taffetas (Vectran/Kevlar) for enduring shape and strength, and the yacht is prepped with staysail running rigging, halyard, and a hydraulic furler (sail not supplied) alongside a hydraulic furling system for the genoa, making sail handling authoritative yet refined thanks to electric winches for the mainsail halyard and overall sail management complemented by three electric winches including the mainsail halyard, each offering three speeds for precise trimming.

Engines and helm stations

Propulsion is entrusted to twin John Deere NS 2 SIB inboard diesel engines delivering 230 hp each, driving through ZF85A20364197 gearboxes rated 168 kW // 230 OJ in a direct drive installation that turns folding propellers with rope cutters on the shafts for peace of mind in debris strewn waters; electronic engine throttles are thoughtfully duplicated at the chart table and the portside navigation station with full engine controls at the helm stations, all set within a Lecomble & Schmitt steering architecture for tactile precision, while a bow thruster amplifies low speed maneuverability, a 3500W-24VDC windlass makes light work of anchoring, and Yacht Controller completes the

refined command suite for precise close quarters handling.

Deck equipment

Elegance meets utility across teak laid surfaces throughout, protected when desired by comprehensive exterior covers, while at the stern a hydraulic platform with remote control and a Tenderlift hydraulic tender platform streamline bathing and launch operations, assisted by a 3.5 m retractable hydraulic gangway on the portside transom and an aft sliding door for seamless flow; an electric plancha grill elevates alfresco dining and aft electric capstans ease mooring, while ground tackle is formidable with an anchor windlass paired with 125 m (Ø16 mm) chain and a 75 kg Spade anchor, backed by a secondary mooring arrangement with 100 m (Ø20 mm) chain, and aft cockpit enclosures with windows and privacy curtains (Nomade 21) ensure comfort and discretion, all set off by a Metallic Charcoal Grey wrapping color that underscores the yacht's modern poise.

Flybridge

The flybridge invites relaxation with generous sunlounger pads beneath a composite hardtop that integrates sky windows, a windshield, lighting, and curtains to tailor shade and ambiance, while a composite bimini in carbon canoe style and a black painted boom with light and cover harmonize form and function and an enclosure with windows converts the space for all weather enjoyment, underfoot teak flybridge flooring adds warmth and grip, elevating every passage into a private terrace above the sea.

Electrical equipment

Self sufficiency and quiet confidence come from a robust electrical backbone

featuring a primary Onan 27 kW 60 Hz generator paired with an auxiliary Onan 19 kW unit rated for 230/50/60 Hz, power management refined by a pack of two inverters (24/220 V, 5000 VA) and a pack of two chargers (220 V, 100 Amp) supported by dedicated battery chargers to keep every system at peak readiness, while shipwide oversight is unified through a yacht management monitoring system displayed on B&G screens to ensure fingertip awareness and control underway or at anchor.

Electronics & navigation

Confidence at the helm is delivered by a comprehensive B&G Navigation Pack encompassing VHF, radar, and AIS, complemented by a B&G autopilot remote for poised, fingertip steering; shallow water awareness is heightened by the B&G Forward Scan sounder and a B&G 12" display in the crew area supports professional operations, while two B&G cameras under the flybridge and a B&G night vision camera on the mast extend visibility day and night, and connectivity comes via 4G and Wi-Fi internet with an Omnimax antenna providing terrestrial TV and AM-FM reception to keep you informed and entertained wherever you cruise.

Accommodation

A four stateroom layout, each with its own en-suite head, promises privacy and poise for extended cruising while two crew cabins and two crew heads ensure seamless service; the owner's cabin features Hi-Fi Atoll with two speakers and a 40" TV on an electric lift, the middle port cabin mirrors the refinement with Hi-Fi Atoll, two speakers, and a 32" TV on an electric lift, both the aft port and aft starboard cabins are equipped with Hi-Fi Atoll, two speakers, and 32" TVs on supports, and the crew quarters benefit from a dedicated B&G 12" display, while in the saloon an elegant double butterfly

table—as on the Lagoon 630 MY—anchors convivial gatherings and electric roller blinds fine tune light and privacy at a touch.

Interior equipment

Climate control is comprehensive with reverse cycle chilled water air conditioning rated at 180,000 BTU and a dedicated reverse cycle system for the furnished port bow compartment, spa like bathrooms feature integrated bidets in the owner's head, aft port, middle port, and aft starboard cabins enhanced by heated towel rails for everyday indulgence, convenience meets discretion with electric roller blinds in the saloon, while a Miele washer/dryer (8 kg/5 kg, forward galley) manages onboard laundry with domestic ease and a HIFI sound system media center crowns the experience with a 55" retractable ceiling TV that vanishes when the moment calls for quiet.

Entertainment & audiovisual

Life on board is scored by a refined hi fi sound system with a central media hub distributing rich audio where it matters most, in the saloon a 55" retractable ceiling TV transforms the space for cinema grade evenings while cabins are enhanced with Hi Fi Atoll systems, speakers, and dedicated TV setups to suit personal rhythms, and a DLNA network ties it all together enabling seamless media sharing across the yacht for a curated ambience in every setting.

Galley

The galley is designed for culinary ambition with an electric oven beneath a capable range hood paired with a Miele microwave plus grill, while a Miele dishwasher handles twelve place settings with quiet efficiency; practicality is

elevated by a sink garbage disposal and a fresh water purifier, cold storage is exemplary with a Samsung double wide side by side refrigerator featuring a bottom drawer freezer, an additional under floor freezer of 92 liters, and a dedicated 24VDC refrigerator, entertaining is effortless with an ice maker serving both the aft cockpit and flybridge, a coffee machine on call, and a wine cooler for 22 bottles complemented by an 80 L fridge to keep vintages at their best.

Safety

Safety is integral and unobtrusive, beginning with fixed smoke detection across six sensors — three in the port hull, two in the starboard hull, and one in the saloon — while fire protection includes a fixed fire fighting system in both engine rooms with remote activation of extinguishers supported by portable fire extinguishers distributed throughout the vessel, and redundancy is assured with manual bilge pumps complemented by automatic high capacity electric bilge pumps quietly standing guard so you can voyage with confidence.

Plumbing systems

Onboard utilities are engineered for independence with dedicated fresh water, black water, and grey water systems designed for reliability and ease of service, and a Sea Recovery Aquamatic 230V watermaker delivering 280 L/h turns the ocean into abundance to sustain extended passages with pristine supply.

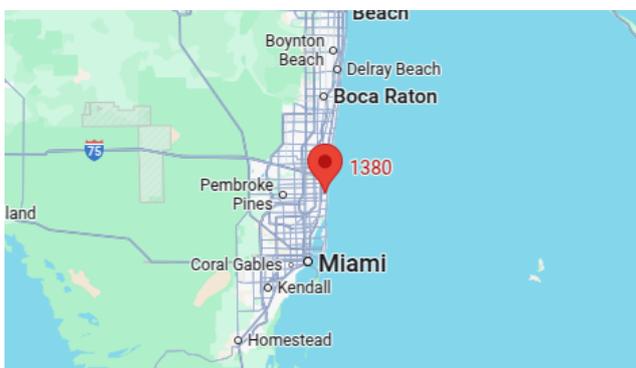
