OVERVIEW

A statement of modern multihull elegance, this 2025, 90-foot sailing catamaran marries sweeping volume with poised performance, crafted in Poland with meticulous European know-how. Her premium fiberglass composite hulls and gleaming fiberglass decks create a light, robust platform that feels as effortless as it is enduring. With a majestic 43-foot beam, she delivers the space, stability, and serenity that discerning sailors expect from a luxury sail yacht—all while preserving the effortless grace that defines a true catamaran. Vast lounging areas flow fore to aft, while broad, shaded terraces invite relaxed afternoons at anchor and elegant evenings under sail, seamlessly blending the ease of a contemporary plastic-composite build with the refinement of a modern superyacht multihull.

Inside, light pours through panoramic glazing to illuminate a salon designed for refined living and effortless entertaining. A gourmet galley serves both intimate dining and festive gatherings, and the main lounge spills out to the cockpit for a naturally indoor-outdoor rhythm at sea. Private accommodations feel calm and cocooning, with a full-beam owner's retreat and beautifully appointed guest suites offering walk-in comfort, generous storage, and spa-style en suites. Thoughtful separation of guest and crew domains preserves discretion, while wide transom steps keep the water always within graceful reach for swimming, tender arrivals, or an effortless launch of water toys.

Underway, the catamaran's balanced sail plan and multihull stability promise confident bluewater passages and whisper-quiet coastal cruising. When the breeze softens, twin Cummins diesel engines provide reliable, economical propulsion and precise maneuvering in tight marinas, complemented by the inherently steady footprint of a large performance cruising catamaran. A 9.514-foot draft opens doors to idyllic anchorages that elude many monohulls

of similar length, while the expansive platform remains reassuringly composed in a range of conditions. Lying in Poland and poised for her first season, this sophisticated sailing catamaran offers a rare union of volume, velocity, and verve—an elegant invitation to explore the world with style and ease.

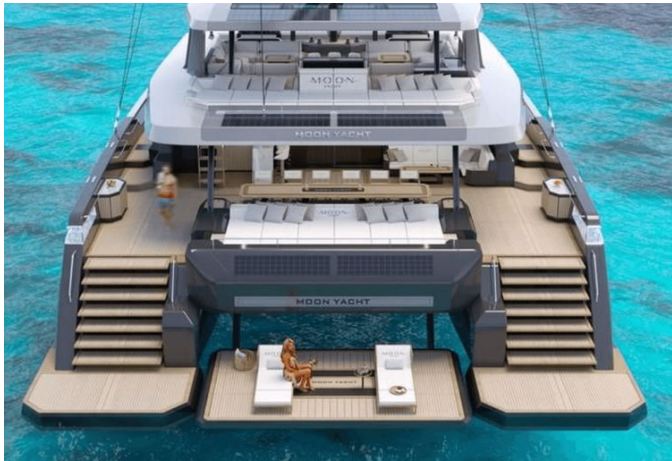

DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Hull, deck and superstructure

Elegantly presented with lacquer-finished hull sides in a colour to be determined, this yacht mirrors that same refined finish across the superstructure and flybridge, their final colour likewise to be determined. Discreet, colorless protective film is applied around the mooring cleats, fairleads, and lifting points to safeguard the pristine surfaces. Underfoot, the aft cockpit, side deck, forward cockpit, and flybridge floors are clad in synthetic teak, offering inviting texture and enduring appeal. In the saloon area, the experience is elevated by an upgrade to glass panoramic windows, welcoming expansive views and abundant natural light.

Interior finish

The interior woodwork is exquisitely finished in HPL offered in premium colours or in carefully selected timber, while the floors are laid in natural wood parquet for a warm, refined foundation. Bathrooms are appointed with quartz walls presented in premium colours and complemented by premium HPL, and the countertops are refined with quartz in a premium colour for a seamless, durable sheen. Side panels and ceilings are elegantly wrapped in synthetic leather and Alcantara in special colours, elevated by natural leather accents that add tactile richness. Ambient highlights include an illuminated wall within the bar island and softly illuminated wardrobe interiors, enhancing both atmosphere and functionality.

Upholstery

Thoughtfully tailored upholstery elevates every social zone, beginning with a

complete suite of external cushions for the aft cockpit, flybridge, and forward cockpit, enhanced by additional cushions in the forward cockpit for extra lounging comfort. A coordinated set of decorative pillows accents the aft and forward cockpits and the flybridge, unifying the spaces with refined style and support. For effortless care and long-lasting appeal, a comprehensive set of external covers protects the navigation station, tables, all cushions, and the bar island.

Sails and rigging

A black-painted aluminium mast crowns the rig, carrying a Hydranet fully battened mainsail set on a canoe boom with lazy jacks and an integrated sail bag, all driven by low-stretch Dyneema running rigging for precise handling. Forward, a Hydranet genoa and a powerful Code Zero expand the sail plan, each supported by electric furling systems for swift, effortless deployment and retrieval, while the mainsail traveler is governed by responsive electric controls. Dedicated rigging for the Code Zero and gennaker ensures optimal performance across wind angles, and five electric winches deliver ample power for fine-tuned trim under load. After dusk, under-spreader lights bathe the deck in clear illumination, extending confident sailing well into the night.

Engines

Power is delivered by two 500 HP Cummins diesel engines with V-drive, turning two folding propellers for efficient thrust and smooth, quiet performance. Precision handling comes courtesy of two induction bow thrusters, complemented by additional engine throttles positioned in the aft cockpit for effortless docking and at the navigation station for convenient control under way. Endurance and reliability are ensured by two 8,000-liter diesel fuel tanks with a fuel transfer system between tanks, water sensors monitoring the fuel

filters, and a fuel filter bypass for each engine to keep you moving even in adverse conditions. Safety is paramount, with an automatic fire extinguishing system protecting the engine rooms.

Deck gear

A powerful 3500W electric windlass commands a 130 kg Ultra Marine anchor with 120 m of galvanized chain, while an additional anchor and windlass add welcome redundancy. A full set of fixed mooring cleats is complemented by two electric mooring winches aft, one to starboard and one to port, and access around the deck is secured by stainless steel front and rear doors. Waterside living is effortless thanks to a dedicated boarding ladder, a swimming ladder, and a deck shower delivering hot and cold water, all served by a hydraulic platform for launching a tender up to 1200 kg. Completing the package, a hydraulic gangway simplifies shore access and a spacious garage accommodates two jet skis, with the jet skis not included.

Electrical system

A premium 120 kWh Lithium LiFePO4 battery pack forms the heart of the yacht's electrical architecture, complemented by two 48V/15000W/200A charger/inverters that seamlessly power all yacht systems. Shore power flexibility is assured with one 125A connection and one 63A connection, while four additional 100A battery chargers provide rapid replenishment and redundancy. An intelligent power management system orchestrates energy flow and integrates generator auto-start with a semi-automatic generator/shore connection transfer switch for effortless operation. Reliable underway and at anchor, the setup is anchored by two 25 kW generators, with solar panels augmenting onboard autonomy. Everyday convenience is elevated with USB sockets thoughtfully placed in the cabins and saloon, along with a set

of induction mobile phone chargers—two in each cabin, one at the navigation station, and one at the helm station.

Plumbing

Engineered for autonomy and absolute confidence at sea, the plumbing system centers on a generous 4,000 L fresh water tank, complemented by a 1,500 L black water tank and an 800 L grey water tank. Delivery and pressure are assured by two fresh water pump units feeding electric toilets with fresh water flush and two 120 L electric water heaters for abundant hot water throughout. For extended cruising, a 230 V watermaker produces 200 to 250 L per hour, while a fresh water shore connection with automatic tank refuelling simplifies time in port. Safety and redundancy are built in with four electric bilge pumps backed by an additional bilge pump system with a double independent configuration, plus two manual bilge pumps and a high water level alarm. On deck, a high pressure water pump makes washing down effortless, and a fuel level indicator positioned near the fuel inlet streamlines bunkering.

Lights

LED navigation lights and a dedicated deck light ensure confident visibility underway, while LED interior lights integrated into the ceiling panels and additional LED lighting in the aft cockpit ceiling create a refined onboard glow. The Interior Ambience Pack introduces discreet, indirect illumination throughout the saloon and cabins, complemented by the Exterior Ambience Pack with indirect lights in the aft cockpit, skirts, side decks, forward cockpit, forward deck deck, and flybridge. Sixteen RGBW underwater lights lend a dramatic radiance at the waterline, the boat's name is elegantly backlit, and dimmers for interior and cockpit lights invite you to tailor the mood to every

moment.

Comfort on board

Comfort aboard is assured by a mechanical ventilation system serving the cabins and a robust 220V air-conditioning installation with a central chiller delivering 200,000 BTU for consistent climate control throughout.

Entertainment is equally elevated, with a JL Audio radio/USB/Bluetooth player powering a meticulously distributed soundscape: four speakers and two subwoofers in the saloon, four speakers and two subwoofers on the flybridge, four speakers and one subwoofer in the aft cockpit, and four speakers in the forward cockpit. Thoughtful finishing touches include four audio staring pilot and one wiper with washer on the window adjacent to the navigation station on the main deck.

Galley

Designed for effortless culinary service and long-range comfort, the galley features two side-by-side refrigerators paired with one freezer to keep provisions impeccably organized, an induction stove for precise and efficient cooking, and an electric oven with microwave function to streamline meal preparation. Cleanup is swift with two dishwashers, while onboard living is supported by a washing machine and a separate dryer. A dinette for the crew and a television screen create a relaxed, practical hub, complemented by generous high and low storage and lockers that ensure every utensil and ingredient has its place.

Saloon

Bathed in natural light from glass panoramic windows, the saloon is an inviting

retreat where electric blinds provide effortless privacy and additional blinds grace the entrance door for a refined finish. A harmonious set of lounge sofas and armchairs gathers around a stylish coffee table, while a dedicated dining area features a dining table accompanied by a coordinated set of dining chairs for elegant meals at sea. Entertaining is elevated by a fully appointed bar with refrigerator, ice maker, induction stove, sink, and generous storage, complemented by a dedicated wine cooler to keep vintages at their best. At the touch of a button, a 65-inch TV screen rises smoothly on its electric lifting system for cinematic viewing. For work underway, an integrated office area offers a desk, chair, and storage, and when it's time to take command, a thoughtfully arranged navigation station with a skipper's seat and full controls ensures confident passage-making.

Cabins

Every cabin is crafted for restorative retreats, with all beds measuring 200 x 180 cm and topped with premium mattresses. Manual blinds on the side windows and hatches allow refined control of light and privacy, while a TV screen paired with a sound bar elevates in-cabin entertainment. Large wardrobes and cabinets offer generous stowage, and in the master and VIP cabins a dedicated vanity and working desk provide a quiet space for preparation or productivity. An openable portlight invites natural ventilation and a whisper of sea air.

Cockpit

Thoughtfully designed for effortless entertaining, the cockpit welcomes you with a large sofa set around a fixed dining table and a set of dining chairs, complemented by a lounge sofa and a fixed coffee table for relaxed conversation. A sleek bar module integrates a refrigerator, ice maker, sink, and

ample storage, with bar stools inviting guests to linger over refreshments. For added convenience, a discreet day head features an electric toilet and a washbasin.

Flybridge

Crowned by a laminated hard top with integrated lights, the flybridge forms an elegant social haven featuring two large sofas paired with two fixed coffee tables. A well-equipped bar with sink, refrigerator, ice maker, and storage keeps refreshments at the ready, while a set of large sunbathing mattresses invites unhurried lounging. For ultimate relaxation, a jacuzzi for four persons anchors the space, and precise handling is ensured by two steering stations with a full set of controls.

Navigation & electronics

Command and control are elevated by a comprehensive suite of navigation and electronics, anchored by three 12-inch chart plotters at the navigation station and complemented by four 16-inch chart plotters on the flybridge. Three i70S instruments—one at the navigation station and two on the flybridge—deliver precise data, while the autopilot, AIS transceiver, radar, and fishfinder expand situational awareness offshore. Communications are robust, with a VHF featuring dual stations at the navigation and helm positions and an additional VHF in the crew area. A Smart Boat system streamlines monitoring, and visibility is enhanced by two parking cameras and two cameras in the engine rooms, one in each. Entertainment and connectivity are equally considered, with a terrestrial TV antenna and 5G/LTE Wi-Fi for worldwide coverage supported by an integrated modem, router, and antenna. An air horn completes the package for confident signaling when required.

Safety equipment

Designed for unwavering peace of mind at sea, the yacht is outfitted with complete rescue equipment for fifteen persons, further supported by an Emergency Position-Indicating Radio Beacon (EPIRB) and a Search and Rescue Transponder (SART) to facilitate swift alerting and location in the event of an emergency.

Commissioning

Commissioning begins with a meticulous antifouling application over an epoxy primer, plus Propospeed and Lightspeed treatments to safeguard underwater surfaces. The yacht is supplied with six mooring lines and ten inflatable fenders complete with fender socks, ensuring secure berthing from day one. Launching is fully managed as part of the handover, and a dedicated Moon Yacht representative is on hand for the first three days of delivery to ensure a seamless start to ownership.

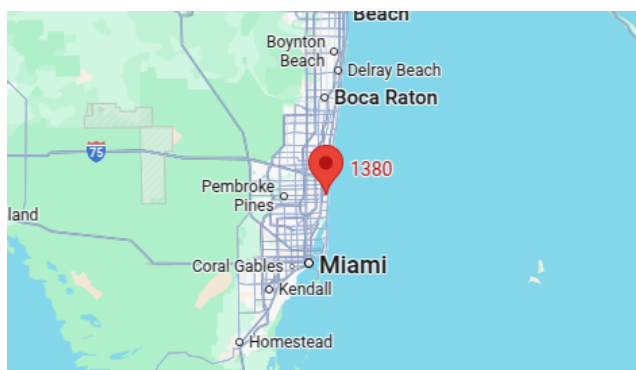
