Dallinghoo is named in tribute to a charming village in Suffolk, England, where the famous Captain Francis Light was born. Captain Light, a British adventurer, was instrumental in establishing the British settlement of Penang, now part of Malaysia. Over 250 years ago, he would have helmed a yacht similar to Dallinghoo while serving the prestigious East India Company. The current owner's dedication to restoring Dallinghoo to her splendid condition is truly commendable. This yacht beautifully marries classic sophistication with modern luxury, capturing the spirit of a contemporary vessel. Her interiors are adorned with rich Burmese teak, and the eye-catching tanbark traditional weave clipper sailcloth harks back to the 18th century.

Dallinghoo offers overnight accommodation for up to 8 guests in 4 spacious en-suite cabins. Initially designed as a charter yacht for journeys to the captivating islands of Burma, she is fully outfitted with a dive compressor and 6 sets of SCUBA equipment for diving enthusiasts, as well as paddleboards, sea kayaks, game fishing rods, a 4.2-meter RIB with a 40hp tender, and a classic McNulty 12ft clinker gaff-rigged sailing dinghy. She currently holds a commercial charter license, enabling her to operate in Thai waters. The cabins were completely refurbished in 2016, and the engine was fully rebuilt in 2019, with zero hours on it.

If you're seeking a yacht that perfectly combines liveaboard comfort with the potential for global sailing, or if you're interested in purchasing a classic yacht for charter purposes, look no further. Dallinghoo is the finest example of a modern classic available in the current boat location, promising great satisfaction to her future owners. DETAILED DESCRIPTION

Section name

This stunning classic yacht is designed for the sophisticated yachtsman, seamlessly combining elegance with practicality. The vessel features a fully equipped commercial-grade stainless steel kitchen, making culinary activities at sea both efficient and pleasurable. Built for ocean voyages, it is outfitted with durable navigation systems, ensuring confidence and dependability on extended journeys. Diving enthusiasts will appreciate the included diving compressor, which facilitates easy and accessible underwater adventures. With an engine range of about 3000 nautical miles, the yacht is capable of long-distance travel without the need for frequent refueling. It also includes a delightful 12-foot clinker-built sailing dinghy, ideal for relaxed sailing or quick shore excursions. The cabins were completely refurbished in 2016, providing contemporary comfort and style throughout the yacht. This vessel exemplifies timeless design and exceptional craftsmanship, delivering an unmatched experience on the water.

Accommodation

This opulent yacht provides sleeping arrangements for up to eight guests across four beautifully appointed double cabins, with additional quarters for the crew. Each cabin underwent a refurbishment in 2016, showcasing a bright cream interior with polished teak paneling and hardwood accents, all set against varnished hardwood flooring. The master suite, positioned aft, features a double bed, a seating nook, generous storage, and a private bathroom with a toilet, sink, and shower. The VIP suite, located midship, also includes a double bed, storage, and a private bathroom. Forward on the port side, there is another double cabin with its own ensuite, while a forward twin cabin offers

upper and lower bunks and an ensuite bathroom.

The captain's quarters, a double cabin situated behind the navigation area, includes an ensuite bathroom and can be offered for guest use if a double bed is needed, with the captain moving to the twin cabin. The crew is housed in a separate four-berth cabin forward, accessed from the deck above, ensuring guest privacy.

The yacht's expansive saloon offers a cozy seating area around a dining table, ideal for social gatherings and relaxation. The navigation area is fitted with a chart table and seating, while the spacious galley is fully equipped to provide gourmet dining experiences. All living areas are fully air-conditioned, ensuring comfort in any weather. Entertainment amenities include a large TV in the main saloon and in both the master and VIP suites. Each cabin is fitted with 220V power outlets and USB charging ports to support modern electronics like phones and cameras.

Rigging

This vessel is a gaff-rigged schooner, showcasing sturdy steel masts paired with aluminum top masts and gaffs, while the wooden booms are encased in glass and epoxy for enhanced durability. The standing rigging is constructed from stainless steel, offering both strength and durability. Each mast is reinforced by three lower shrouds and one upper shroud, with triatic stays linking the masts. The rigging setup also includes lower and upper running backstays, a bowsprit with whisker stays and spreaders, and a bobstay with a dolphin striker. The yacht's air draft reaches 22 meters, and it features a total sail area of 260 square meters (2,800 square feet).

The sail collection is remarkable, comprising a main sail of 88.9 square meters (957 square feet), a foresail of 59.9 square meters (645 square feet), a staysail, a jib/yankee, a jib top, a main top sail, and a fore top sail. All sails are crafted from tanbark traditional weave clipper sailcloth and remain in excellent

condition, ensuring both performance and visual appeal.

Outfitted with 12 Lewmar winches, the yacht includes two Lewmar 48 3-speed racing winches, four Lewmar 44ST self-tailing winches, four Lewmar 48ST self-tailing winches, and two Lewmar 54ST self-tailing winches. These premium winches facilitate efficient sail management, making the yacht a joy to navigate and a testament to exceptional craftsmanship.

Galley, sports and entertainment

The yacht's kitchen is a culinary haven, outfitted with commercial-grade stainless steel and complemented by stylish wooden cabinetry. It includes built-in chest refrigerators, a 220V electric bar fridge in the kitchen, and another 220V bar fridge beneath the saloon bar. For freezing, there is a spacious seawater-cooled freezer set to -20°C and a 140-litre domestic freezer in the storage room. An ice maker adds to the convenience. The kitchen is equipped with a commercial 5-burner stove featuring a gas oven and grill, large square stainless steel sinks, a microwave, and a washing machine. It is fully stocked with crockery, cutlery, and utensils, providing multiple sets for gourmet dining, and includes two Krups coffee machines.

The yacht offers extensive bar facilities with a wide selection of wine, champagne, and spirits. Dining options feature a teak dining table on the aft deck that seats up to eight guests with director's chairs and bench seating, as well as a spacious dining saloon for eight guests.

For those passionate about sports, the yacht is equipped with a portable Bauer petrol diving compressor and a Maximator MX 140 with a double filling hose. It includes six complete sets of scuba gear, two dive computers, and four dive torches. Water sports gear features two double-seater pioneer sea kayaks and two pioneer solid core stand-up paddleboards. Fishing enthusiasts will enjoy the two trolling game rods and two light spinning rods.

Onboard entertainment is exceptional, with an LG Smart 3D 42-inch TV in the main saloon, LG Smart 32-inch TVs in both the master and VIP cabins, and an LG 24-inch TV in the captain's cabin. A Harmon Kardon portable USB speaker delivers high-quality sound, and two hard drives provide a vast collection of 2,000 movies, TV shows, cartoons, and documentaries. The yacht also boasts a large library of books and numerous deck lounge cushions for relaxation.

Machinery

The yacht is driven by a powerful Perkins 185HP diesel engine, completely overhauled in June 2019 to zero hours, guaranteeing peak performance and dependability. It sails smoothly at 8 knots and can achieve a top speed of 10 knots, with an impressive range of approximately 3000 nautical miles. The steering is managed by a 12V heavy-duty hydraulic system with an autopilot, ensuring seamless and accurate navigation. The gearbox, a PRM500, was newly installed in September 2016, enhancing the vessel's mechanical efficiency.

Regarding tankage, the yacht is fitted with a 2,500-litre steel fuel tank situated in the keel, allowing for extended journeys without frequent refueling. Water storage is generous, with 3,000 litres held in two stainless steel tanks, and there is a 600-litre holding tank for black water.

The electrical system is extensive, featuring a 24V house bank system powered

by 12 x 2V 800Ah batteries, along with 2 x 12V sealed batteries for the 24V main engine and 2 x 12V batteries for the 24V main generator. Additionally, there is a 12V battery for the backup generator. The bow thruster is supported by 2 x 12V 160 A/hr Sonnenschein batteries, and the autopilot is powered by a 12V 160 A/hr Sonnenschein battery. Battery charging is handled by a Victron Multiplus 70 Amp charger for the house bank, a Victron Centaur charger for the bow thruster (installed in 2018), and Victron chargers for each battery bank. The yacht also includes a Victron 24V 5000VA inverter and is equipped with 220V shore power.

For power generation, the yacht is equipped with a main generator, a 2009 Northern Light M864W.3 with a capacity of 20KVA, and a standby generator, a 2014 Paguro 3 with a silent running capacity of 10KVA. The engine-driven main alternator, installed in 2018, provides 4KVA, and the electrical system is further supported by a Leece Neville 24V 175 A/hr alternator. This comprehensive machinery setup ensures that the yacht is well-prepared for both short excursions and long-distance voyages.
