Two private double berths with two private full heads. Forward V berth has large hangning locker and additional storage. The dinnette in the mainsalon is to starboard making for ease of access forward while to port there is a wine/liquor cabinet between two comfortable seats. The aft head with shower is very large and is aft of the galley to port. Aft private double berth has hanging locker and storage. Forward facing navigation station is to starboard of companionway and opposite galley. For a 40 foot cruiser this Bavaria has a lot of storage space, great seating, excellent opening portlights and hatches. Interior looks nearly new.


