Interior

White gelcoat finish with oiled teak highlights. Teak and holly cabin sole. Jabsco marine toilet under flush hatch. 3" foam settee cushions with choice of Sunbrella fabric. Igloo white cooler / lower companionway step. Port and starboard lockers for electronics/storage. (4) Access panels below settees.

Hull & Deck

White gel coat hull finish with gel coat boot stripe Two-tone gel coat deck finish. 10 year transferable blister warranty. Biaxial e-glass with unidirectional reinforcing to ABS standards. Sandwich construction with Corecell closed cell A-foam. Vinyl-ester resin system throughout hull, deck, and structure. Antimony lead fin keel with large bulb and deep sump for keel bolt access. Teak toe rail and exterior companionway trim, oil finish. (4) Molded custom portlights in cabin house. 16' ergonomic cockpit with (4) scuppers to CE standards. Cockpit lazarette locker with flush-molded hatch. Foredeck anchor locker with flush-molded hatch. Molded hull structure, interior liner, and chainplate knees, gelcoated white.

Mechanical System

Yanmar 2YM20-SD20, 14hp Saildrive w/ Gori 2-blade folding propeller. Engine panel and throttle control in cockpit. 10 gallon stainless steel fuel tank with inspection plate and gauge. High aspect ratio Eglass rudder. Jefa aluminum rudder stock and composite bearings.

Custom aluminum foil section swept back double spreaders. Harken sheaves and Spinlock line clutches throughout. Awlgrip finish on mast, boom and spreaders. Harken traveler system. Bonded Luff Track and battcars for mainsail. Stainless mooring points (cleat, padeyes, chocks). Continuous standing rigging for easy tuning at deck level. Slim line fore deck hatch. 316 stainless steel fittings and 1x19 stainless standing rigging. Companionway hatch with double slider. Custom 316 stainless steel chainplates. Magnetic compass. Sailtec hydraulic headstay with remote panel in cockpit. Vang-Master boom vang - no topping lift required.

ABYC standards throughout. Complete running rigging package, including lazy-jacks. (1) 100 amp 12VDC marine battery. No winches - Sails controled by macro & micro sheeting systems. (1) 12VDC battery switch and Blue Sea distribution panel. Spartite kit for partners. (2) Cabin lights. G0 mast step. (1) Cockpit-mounted manual bilge pump. (1) Holding tank plumbed for pump out.
