- Bulk heads for master stateroom, main cabin area and head have all been replaced. (2003)
- Bulk head for anchor rope locker has been replaced. (2004)
- 6 porthole windows, 2 in master stateroom, 1 head, 1 cabin have been removed and enclosed. (2004)
- The top cap of the boat from the back of the engine room to the bow on both sides has been ground out and fiber glassed together for additional strength and no leaking. (2004)
- Removed old cockpit flooring and everything underneath. Replaced supports and floor. (2005)

- Aft main bulk head was removed and replaced. (2006)
