Construction:

RCD Status: The yacht conforms with the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC (Recreational Craft Directive) and is categorised A – "Ocean" (or Cat B – whichever is appropriate)

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- · Hand laid GRP construction with isophthalic gelcoat backed by initial lay up of powder bound mat and isophthalic resin.
- Balsa cored sandwich construction for increased panel stiffness and optimum weight distribution.
- Hull stiffened by bonded in bulkheads plus frames and stringers.
- · Underwater sections from stem to keel further stiffened by utilizing an aramid (kevlar) laminate to increase impact resistance.
- Transom includes hinging transom door/swimming platform.
- Swept teak laid ring deck plus forward and aft coachroof areas.
- Deck stiffened with balsa core, with plywood backing pads in way of deck fittings.
- Deck edge incorporates raised bulwark with teak cap rail.
- Inset cavita line in topsides.
- Painted boot top, waterline and antifouling.
- Blue hull.
- 2000 Awlgrip (2007).
- Copper coat and all new skin fittings (2008).

Keel & Rudder:

- Lead/antimony ballast keel; fin keel with vestigial bulb.
- GRP semi balanced rudder mounted on half depth skeg with bronze heel fitting.

Rudder supported with stainless steel bar rudder stock.

Summary of Accommodation:

- Interior furniture finished in timber.
- Two double berths and three single berths in four cabins excluding the saloon.

Description of layout from forwards:

Forepeak:

- Chain locker with access through foredeck hatch.
- · Watertight bulkhead.
- Chain locker drains directly overboard.

Forward Cabin:

- Centre line double berth with large storage lockers beneath.
- Hanging lockers to port and starboard sides.
- Curve fronted ships topside lockers to port and starboard.
- Opening deck hatch gives light and ventilation.

Starboard Guest Cabin:

- Twin single berths, with stowage space beneath the lower berth.
- Large hanging locker to forward bulkhead.
- Vanity desk to aft bulkhead.
- Opening hatch gives light and ventilation.

Forward Heads:

- Finished in wipe clean laminate surfaces.
- Towel rail, toothbrush/glass folder and toilet roll holder.
- Floor in decorative teak finish.
- Teak grating in shower area.
- · Stowage locker.
- Opening deck hatch provides light and ventilation.

Saloon:

- Large C shaped settee to starboard side with extending leaf dining table.
- Directors' chairs provide additional seating to all sides of the dining table.
- Generous stowage space beneath settee.
- Tankage beneath saloon floor.
- Built in two seater sofa to portside.
- Outboard of settee and sofa are topside lockers with hull windows beneath.
- Forward of port sofa is a large cocktail locker.
- · Saloon windows light area.
- Opening deck hatches and dorade vents provide ventilation.

Navigation Area:

- · Navigation desk to take a half folded admiralty chart, with chart stowage space beneath lid, drawer space beneath chart table.
- Draw out mounting for lap top computers plus pencil and ruler drawer space above chart table.
- Chart table seat covered in water resistant covering.
- Wet hanging lockers aft of chart table seat.

Galley:

- Large U shaped galley, one step down from saloon.
- Worktop space with deeply fiddled edges.
- Stowage lockers for food, crockery, pots and pans plus cutlery drawers.

Starboard Passage Cabin:

- Accessed aft of navigation area.
- A single mid level height berth above a built in locker/sideboard unit.
- This area can be used as a lobby entrance/dressing room to the aft cabin.
- Opening port light gives light and ventilation

Aft Owner's Cabin:

- Large centerline double berth, with deep drawer space beneath.
- Twin curved seats flowing away from the berth with curved stowage lockers above.
- Generous hanging locker space, vanity units with storage space and dresser unit for forward bulkhead.
- Light and ventilation is provided by opening deck hatch, portlights and hull topsides window.

En-suite Heads:

- Aft of owner's cabin.
- Towel rail, tooth brush/glass holder and toilet roll holder.
- Finished in wipe clean laminate finishes.

Opening portlight for light and ventilation.

Cockpit:

- · Wheel steering pedestal.
- Whitlock Reflex with pedestal mounted compass.
- Engine instrument and starting panel mounted on pedestal.
- Cockpit seats and sole finished in teak.
- Cockpit table.
- Stainless steel grab handles each side of companionway.

Builder's Comments:

Stiff, immensely strong, yet light enough to maintain optimum performance across the full range of ocean

cruising conditions, the Moody 54 has been designed without compromise. The balance and power of her

underwater sections and lead keel give superb sail carrying and stability for swift passage times.

This sparkling performance is complemented by her ease of handling by two people. Standard equipment includes furling for all sails, electrically powered primary winches and a 10hp bowthruster. Her powerful sail plan, on Seldon's triple spreader rig, includes a cutter rig with self-tacking staysail.
