Aft with queen bed to port, settee to starboard, access to cockpit amidships, 4 drawer bureau. Additional storage to starboard. Forward of stateroom, head and basin to port, large stall shower opposite to starboard. One full hanging locker.

Moving forward to starboard is a guest head which also serves as a day head.

Forward of this head is a settee, which can also serve as a bunk (open to companionway), full length wardrobe.

Guest Stateroom:

Opposite to port – upper and lower guest stateroom with full length wardrobe, bureau and storage below lower bunk.

Settee to port with coffee table/cabinet storage. To starboard, matching barrel back chairs with credenza between (3 pieces are original consolidated)

Her most recent refit in 2000, at Derecktor's Shipyard in Mamaroneck, NY, was approximately \$1.3m. She has had a new bottom, rewired, replumbed, new engines, generators, pumps, compressors, etc. All electronics and aids to navigation have been replaced or updated. Brightwork recently stripped - the yacht is hauled and painted every year. The detail incorporated into this yacht is exquisite. She is a classic which has defied time and has many years left with the proper care. EMPRESS is being offered at a fraction of her replacement cost, and is available for immediate use, in turn key










