In 2009 she was sailed to and from Southern Ireland and in 2010 has completed a return trip to Southern Brittany. She is well maintained by the current partnership but prior to 2007, Berthon completed all maintenance work including wintering. All invoices/accounts are available for inspection and the current annual running costs are approximately £4000 per share including berthing costs and separate lockup store. Date of last survey: 1998.

## **General Comments**

Well specified and nicely looked after example of this popular Judel/Vrolijk designed aft-cockpit cruising yacht. Designed to be easily sailed single-handed, the 41CR has all her primary control lines lead aft to the helm (and not the companionway like most other yachts), enabling complete control from the helm seat. Her fully battened mainsail and self-tacking jib affords her blistering performance in all wind strengths.
