Broker's Comments

AVOCATION is a well maintained and nicely updated Swan 48. She features a 2008 Offshore Spars carbon fibre triple spreader mast with carbon boom with new Navtec rod rigging and Reckmann roller furling. She has been well cared for and offers an excellent layout for both offshore & coastal racing, and cruising.

Construction

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- Solid fibreglass/aramid hybrid with polyester resin hull laminate.
- White NGA gel coat hull.
- Blue waterline and sheer stripes.
- Longitudinal and transverse stiffeners throughout the interior.
- Bronze through hull fittings.
- Foam cored deck with fibreglass/aramid hybrid construction and polyester resin.
- 2 x Cockpits, each with their own companionway, separated with a bridge deck.
- Teak decking glued and vacuum bagged.

Keel & Rudder:

- Fin keel with 'L' bulb.
- Spare rudder.

- Fresh water cooled engine via heat exchanger.

- Double stainless steel sinks with hot and cold pressurized water.
- 2 x foot pumps, 1 x raw water and 1 x fresh water.
- Dish rack over sinks, drains to sink.

Heads/Showers:

- Hot and cold pressure water deck showers in cockpit.

Heating & Ventilation:

- Caframo fans throughout the yacht with timer and fan speed controls (2008/9).
- Dome vent on foredeck.
- Dorade vent forward of mast with 2 x cowls and dome vent, 12v outlet and stainless steel protection bar over.
- Forced air heating with thermostats throughout yacht.

Entertainment:

- Pioneer speakers in 2 x forward guest cabins.
- Speakers in the head liner of aft master cabin.
- Sony AM/FM radio with CD player.
- 5-way speaker selector switches, 1 x for each cabin, 1 x for the main saloon and 1 x for each for the cockpits.
- Sony speakers in aft cockpit.

Lighting:

- 2 x Reading lights at the head of the berth in aft master cabin.
- Bi-colour bow light, stern light, steaming light, deck light and anchor light.
- LED lights for overhead, reading and navigation (2008/9).
- Deck lights under lower spreaders.

Accommodation

Summary of Accommodation:

- Sleeps 6, 2 in each of the sleeping cabins.
- Sleeps an additional 2 in the main saloon.
- Burmese teak veneer over machine ply, solid teak or laminated teak interior furniture, finished with hand rubbed varnish to a satin finish.
- Teak and holly, lock down, cabin sole throughout.
- Cabin sole re-varnished (2011).
- Vinyl over panelling headliner.
- Main saloon table cover.
- Canvas covers for cabin sole (2011).
- Interior re-varnished approx. 2011/2012.

Description of layout from forwards:

Forward Heads Compartment:

- Located on the centreline in the bow.
- Access door to each of the guest cabins.
- White gel coated GRP panel to waist height, teak above.
- Jabsco manual marine WC.
- Y valve with holding tank.
- Sink with hot and cold pressure water.
- Telephone type shower.
- Cupboards outboard port side.
- New mirror to starboard.

2 x Forward Guest Cabins:

- Essentially mirror guest cabins aft of the forward heads compartment.
- 2 x Single bunk berths in each.
- Hanging locker in each.
- Door forward to the forward heads compartment in each.
- Door aft to the main saloon in each.
- Pioneer speakers in each.

Main Saloon:

- Located aft of the forward guest cabins.
- L shaped settee to port around the fixed dining table.
- Storage behind the seat back.
- Straight settee to port with storage behind the seat back.
- Shelves and lockers port and starboard.
- 2 x Moveable arm chairs for inboard side of dining table.

Navigation Station:

- Located aft of the main saloon and on the starboard side.
- Forward facing with chart storage and drawers.
- Surrounded with navigation and communications equipment and breaker panels.

Galley:

- Located opposite the navigation station on the port side and in the walkway to the aft master cabin.

Aft Master Cabin:

- Centreline double berth.
- New mirror forward.
- 2 x Hanging lockers.
- Numerous other lockers.
- Drawers under the berth.
- Speakers in the headliner.
- 2 x Reading lights at the head of the bed.
- Ladder to the aft companionway on centreline and foot of bed.

Aft Heads Compartment:

- Located starboard side forward of the master cabin.
- White gel coated GRP panel to waist height, teak above.
- Jabsco manual marine WC.
- Y valve with holding tank.
- Sink with hot and cold pressure water.
- Telephone type shower.

Deck Equipment

- Carbon Offshore Spars mast with triple spreaders (2008).
- Harken spinnaker pole track and slider on front of mast.
- Trisail track.
- Checkstays.
- Carbon boom.
- Carbon spinnaker pole.

- Reckmann headsail roller furling (2008).

- 2 x Aft cockpit lockers.
- Stainless steel BBQ grill (unused).
