Construction

RCD Status: The yacht conforms with the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC (Recreational Craft Directive) and is categorised A – "Ocean"

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- Epoxy resin infused closed cell sandwich core construction.
- Carbon fibre chain plates.
- Vacuum consolidated GRP laminate strong back with UD reinforcements.
- Painted hull in dark brown (Porsche macadama brown metallic) without waterline and ornamental stripes.
- Isophthalic gelcoated deck in white
- Nenyler resin infused closed cell sandwich core deck; carbon fibre reinforcements.
- Inherent thermal and sound insulation.
- Deck covered with Flexiteek 6mm teak-coloured vinyl sheeting with white or black seams.
- Self-draining cockpit.

Keel & Rudder:

- Semi-balanced, profiled rudder with self-aligning roller bearings.
- Standard composite iron/lead keel, t-shaped.
- Stainless steel keel bolts.

Machinery

- 1 x Yanmar 110hp diesel engine.
- Engine control at helm station starboard.
- Fuel filter/water separator.
- Engine room sound insulated and illuminated.
- Stainless steel propeller shaft.

Crew Cabin:

- King sized berth on starboard with separated office table, double settee, locker at port side, large heads compartment and separate shower.

Saloon:

- Special saloon layout –dining area at starboard side.

Single crew cabin on port side has been converted for use as a workshop and storage area for spares.

Navigation Area:

- Seat with storage.
- Locker above chart table for instruments and books.
- Space to mount electronics.
- 230v/12v outlet.
- Storage in the chart table.
- LED chart light.

Galley:

- L-shaped galley with huge lockers and drawers.

Utility Room:

- Multipurpose storage combination portside aft of main saloon.

Aft Cabin Section:

- Several lockers.
- Each cabin with individual heads compartment and shower.
- Semi-separated berths.

Heads/Shower:

- Heads and shower in forward cabin with electrical WC.
- Heads and shower in the aft cabins with electric WCs.
- Corian solid surface black quartz with stand alone Corian basin in each head.

- 2 x Secondary winches – 54 AST.

- Opening transom hatch with hydraulic rams, remote control.

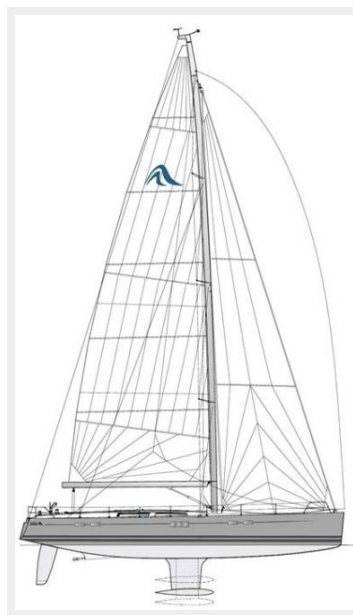
