Accommodations include identical (rare) port and starboard staterooms with two twin berths in each. Berths convert to Queen berth utilizing a matching padded insert. Each hull has a head compartment with stall shower forward. The dining & galley have Corian countertops and a large settee with folding leaf, hi-lo table. The wheelhouse has twin settees with the helm forward to starboard. Interior cabinetry and paneling features varnished Anigre wood. The KIWI CACHE is a good example of the dramatic increased interior volume available in a Catamaran design, her large comfortable salon and cathedral-like, awesome galley and dining area give her the feel of a yacht twice her length.
