- Galley in next on port side with passage opening in to the main saloon.

- Main companionway is on centreline, with wide steps.
- Nav. Station is opposite with double helm seat, opening chart table and drawers.
- Main saloon is very open, with fixed teak table offset to port with two removable teak chairs and settees on either side.
- Guest cabin to port with upper/lower berths.
- Opposite is one berth at waist height with lots of extra drawers beneath.
- Second heads compartment is forward.
- Beautiful woodwork in teak with a teak and holly cabin sole.
- Screens.
- Liquor locker under table.
- Custom chart table lid for laptop.

- Custom halyard arrangement – Port side: spinnaker halyard, genoa halyard, spinnaker halyard, luff reef, leech reef. Starboard side: staysail/pole lift, genoa halyard, main halyard, luff reef, leech reef.
- Carbon fibre spinnaker pole.
- Eye on boom for preventer.
- Hydraulic outhaul Navtec – 10.
- Hydraulic babystay Navtec – 10.
- Hydraulic backstay and vang Navtec, using system 50 control panel.
- Lazy jacks retractable at gooseneck.
- Additional staysail tracks on coach roof including cars.
- Mast steps.
- Burgee halyards.
- Mast cleats.

- Genoa sheet winches, 2 x L66CEST, control button aft/outboard of each winch.
- Main sheet winch, L50 CEST, electric including jammer in front of winch Spinlock XX0812.
- Traveller control winch, L48 CST.
