Chesapeake Bay - Allen Boatbuilders - Markley Hull

The original owners built this custom Chesapeake 46' with Allen Boatbuilders and still own her today. The vessel has lives in a covered slip, full time, keeping her away from the elements and it shows. She is hauled twice per year for bottom inspection and bottom painted and prop-speed applied whenever needed.

She is extremely efficient with the Cummins 450 engine cruising at a comfortable 16 knots and burning only 12 gallons per hour.

This is the perfect vessel for someone who is looking to cruise and fish in a classic quality Downeast style boat that has been babied by the original owners her entire life.

New 2011 Fusion AM/FM/iPod Stereo – speakers in wheelhouse/salon & cockpit. There is a flatscreen TV mounted on an adjustable arm in the cabin and Tracvision Satellite system. All upholstery inside and at helm deck upgraded in 2013 to durable Naugahyde material.


