The navigation station is aft of the settee and the galley is opposite to starboard. There is a quarter berth cabin to port suitable for two children or small adults.

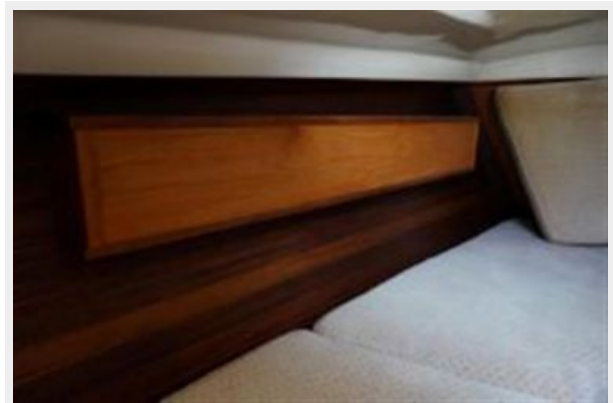

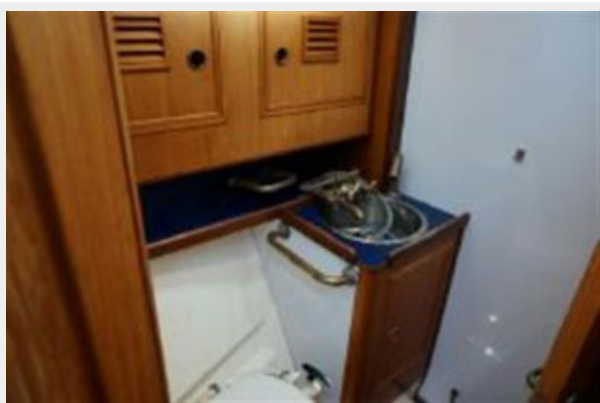

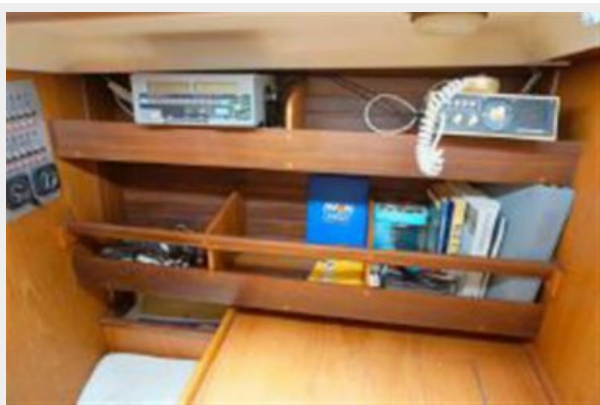
