The large cockpit of this catamaran flows directly into the salon via the retractable coach roof making it very comfortable to relax and enjoy the spacious salon. With a wrap around settee you can sit back and take in the views. The galley down arrangement to port is clean and efficient with plenty of storage. With two queen berths, one in each hull and a full walk in shower and head this boat feels like a much larger boat.


