The 43 SX Eastbay is highly desirous and sought after. She offers a fully enclosed air-conditioned and heated salon/helm that makes year round comfortable cruising possible, both North and South. Couple that with excellent visibility and speeds approaching 30 knots makes her the ideal yacht for both weekends and longer range cruising. Pearl has 2 staterooms, galley down and split head, shower room is across companionway from head. She's tastefully decorated and in exceptional condition.

- Replaced cushion vinyl in cockpit, port and starboard bench seats

- Teak decks cleaned
- Bright work sanded and recoated
- Windshield and dorade canvas covers resown
- New aft and intermediate cutlass bearings
- Props tuned and balanced
- Engines aligned
- Engine room detailed
