Construction

The hull is constructed with superior techniques and materials. The hull is fiberglass and the decks are Divinycell cored. Vinylester resin is used in the first three layers of the hull lay-up process to prevent future blistering problems.

- Hand laid solid fiberglass hull; 7/8" thick bottom, 5/8" thick above the waterline
- Hand laid fiberglass decks, deckhouse, and flybridge; cord with high strength Divinycell
- Hull/Deck joint through-bolted every 6 inches; sealed with 3M 5200 and glassed over with

3 layers of fiberglass
