The vessel can be boarded from port or starboard through deckhouse doors. The covered **Aft Deck** has built-in windows and a large skylight and is finished in Honduran mahogany. This sundeck is surrounded by custom built-in bench seating. In the center of the deck is a large cabinet with custom pop-up BBQ aft and built-in ice boxes forward. Balance of brightwork had two coats of varnish. Windshield wipers system replaced. Shafts realigned, new strut bearings and muff couplings and all underwater gear examined. Sheer strakes and chine logs recaulked. Speed Prop applied to shafts and props.

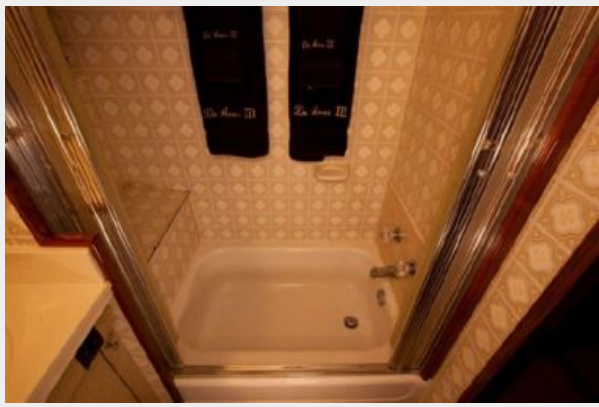
