Construction

RCD Status: Our understanding is that the yacht is exempt from the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC (Recreational Craft Directive) as she was built and placed into use within the EU prior to 1998.

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- Hull constructed in single skin.
- Finished in gelcoat (white awlgrip paint finish).
- Blue coaming, cove and boot stripes (new swan colours).
- Bulkheads in marine plywood, laminated to hull and deck.
- GRP reinforcements with foam core.
- GRP engine bed with steel inserts.

• Deck constructed in GRP sandwich overlaid with teak; teak decks replaced 1998 and recaulked and sanded in 2008 and 2011.

• Teak laid in cockpits, side decks, bridge deck and foredeck (new teak in cockpit, 2007; further work completed 2008/09).


