Sleeps up to five with two forward in a V-berth stateroom, two amidships in the main saloon which becomes a private stateroom separated from the V-berth forward by closing off the dressing room head between. Fifth berth is aft of the main saloon and extends towards the stern and under the starboard side cockpit as a quarter berth.

All interior surfaces are bright finished teak and painted crem shell ivory enamel. The cabin sole throughout is bright finished solid teak.

Particularly delightful in that all of her cabin roof knees and main entry beam are elaborately carved.

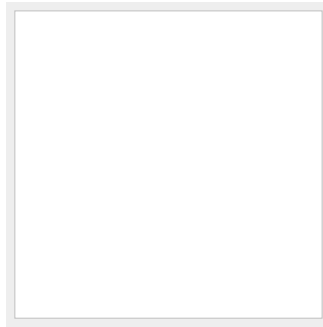
