The 6'4" headroom, skylights, opening hatches and ports offer abundant natural light and good ventilation. Sleep in air conditioned comfort while at dock. The V berth is forward with a hanging locker, side shelves and an opening hatch. The double sided salon features a, u shaped settee to starboard, drop leaf dining table, settee and a forward facing navigation station to port. The fully equipped galley is at the base of the companionway steps to port, opposite you find the large private head with separate shower followed by the large aft cabin with double berth, and hanging locker.
