Description

Mast & Rigging

- Anodized aluminum mast and boom, factory option painted in white
- Double spreader rig 2 shrouds with chafe guards 2 lower shrouds with chafe guards 1 forestay with manual furler
- Anodized aluminium transversal crossbeam
- Adjustable Lazy Jacks with spreaders
- Composite longitudinal beam
- Factory option for bowsprit and owner modified rig, consisting of: 1) SS wire "dolphin" stays to replace Dyneema, 10mm stranded 2) ProFurl system of 8mm stranded SS stay (non-structural) with aluminum furling extrusion and ProFurl drum furler 3) Furling line led parallel to jib furler on deck, all Harken blocks changed from single to double, leading to electric winch and double rope furler at steering station
- Spectra gennaker sheets, Harken turning blocks, per Lagoon spec Red, white, blue custom sail by Incidences, approximately 150 SqM, recut from flying type sail to full furling luff sail
- Original flying sail hardware kept as spare for "next sail", consisting of: 1) Facnor continuous line furling drum, tack swivel, head swivel with 2:1 halyard sheave/block, rope luff from sail before modified. (Approx value of this spare hardware is \$5K) 2) Three (3) Harken winch handles 3) Harken Deluxe boson's chair

Sails

- Mainsail: Approximately 150 m², three reef points and hardware, full battens, ball bearing load bearing cars and track by Facnor
- Self-tacking jib, roller furling and roller furl reefing: 82 m², new dk. Blue UV roller furling cover.
- Gennaker, roller furling, Dacron/mylar, approximately 152m², white UV roller furling cover.
- Lazy stack and jacks, color "natural", modified by owner from Lagoon bag: 1) Full battens installed to hold lazy jacks 2) Reinforced, re-stitched again in July, 14.


