DETAILED INFORMATION

Owner's Comments

We have had ELIXIER since new, taking delivery in Italy where she was built. We sailed her in the Med, and then brought her home. Sailing in Brittany, the Atlantic coasts of Spain and Portugal, as well as the Western Isles and back via the Atlantic coast of Ireland. Much of our sailing has been just husband and wife, but she comfortably accommodates 6. We have maintained her to a very high level over the years, with a full repaint (awlgrip) in 2014, and a refurbishment of the teak decks. She has wintered out of the water every year and has been fully serviced throughout.

Construction

RCD Status: The yacht conforms with the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC (Recreational Craft Directive) and is categorised A – "Ocean" (or Cat B – whichever is appropriate)

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- GRP hull.
- Teak deck.
- Dark blue gel coat/midnight blue awlgrip (2014 repaint).

2.10m lead keel.

- Engine room insulation made of flameproof material chosen for both heat insulation and sound deadening purposes.

Accommodation

Summary of Accommodation:

- The interior joinery is American Cherry stained mahogany which has been treated with polyurethane and then buffed to a shine.
- The interior boats an excellent calibre of finishing throughout.
- The solid colour fabrics and materials have been chosen with special care.
- Aft portholes.
- Some of interior varnished in 2014.

Portside and Starboard Aft Cabin:

Cockpit

- Large, deep and particularly well protected.
- Uninterrupted view of foredeck.
- All halyards, sheets and reefing lines are led back to the cockpit.





