DETAILED INFORMATION

INTRODUCTION

The Talaria 40 is a twin engine, waterjet driven, versatile lake/ocean cruiser built with quality, comfort and safety in mind. She sleeps two comfortably forward and includes a head with separate shower, and full galley. There is a lounge seating and an optional dining table that can transform to an extra berth in the pilothouse. Additional seating is in the cockpit.

CONSTRUCTION

Hinckley DualGuard composit construction of the hull is Kevlar E-glass hybrid and balsa core, Scrimped with vinylester resin. Deck and cockpit are E-glass and balsa core, molded with polyester resin. The deck and cockpit sole have a molded-in nonskid pattern. All Forespar Marelon seacocks.

- Flag Blue Awlgrip Topsides
- Light Cream Gelcoat Cabin house and Deck
- Double Cream Bootstripe
- Black painted Bottom

Deck Features:

- Foredeck has a flush anchor locker with a custom pneumatic strut that holds open the anchor locker hatch.
- Starboard mid-deck molded in locker can be used for storage
- Aft, the heavy duty fiberglass swim platform has teak insert treads, stainless steel bracket and half round, and a stainless steel telescoping 3-step folding swim ladder.

More:

- Rounded, tapered, varnished teak toe rail with Hinckley profile
- Varnished teak eyebrow molding around cabin top
- Varnished teak handrails on cabin and pilothouse top\
- Four (4) opening elliptical ports with screens on house sides
- Hinckley pilothouse mast with spotlight and 24? Radome are painted to match deck.
- Three (3) low profile Lewmar opening aluminum hatches with screens
- Custom Hinckley 316L stainless steel bow chocks
- Bow, stern and springline 316L SS mooring cleats
- Wichard padeyes with chafe strips to hang fenders
- Stainless steel half round on fiberglass molded rubrail

COCKPIT

- Access to the cockpit is side boarding or at the transom
- Side boarding access is via a teak deck pad that mounts port or starboard
- There are two (2), port and starboard, removable boarding steps that are teak with aluminum legs that mount inside the coaming
- Hinged transom door starboard in molded frame offers access to the cockpit or to the heavy-duty fiberglass swim platform that has a heavy-duty stainless steel folding ladder.
- The cockpit coaming is varnished teak. The cockpit sole has a molded-in nonskid surface and direct overboard drainage scuppers.
- Cockpit Bimini Hinckley designed 3-bow Diklon Natural cockpit bimini
- Custom side and rear curtains can totally enclose the cockpit
- Seating facing aft is built-in to the port and starboard engine boxes that are topped with varnished teak and separate the cockpit from the pilothouse
- The cushioned bottom and back seats are finished in sunbrella fabric
- Engine boxes are hinged and have hydraulic lift to give easy access to the engines.
- More seating is available with an aft cockpit forward-facing settee on the port side with matching cushion.

More Cockpit Amenities:

- Full Ivory-color cockpit cover attaches to pilothouse with snaps around cockpit coaming
- · Courtesy lights in pilothouse entry
- Cockpit courtesy lighting under the side decks
- Deck shower with cockpit spigot with a hot and cold mixing valve is located in the cockpit under the port coaming to the left of the engine cover seat
- Removable, customized, plastic tile squares cockpit sole decking
- Cockpit floodlight is mounted on the pilothouse top mast and is painted to match deck
- Fishing rod holders on port and starboard aft decks
- A lazarette/bait box is built-in the aft deck

PILOTHOUSE

Pilothouse is finished with:

- Five (5) pilothouse windows: two (2) sliding side windows, three (3) fixed forward with heavy-duty, self-parking, intermittent windshield wipers and fresh water washers.
- Insulated white overhead has two (2) forward acrylic opening hatches
- Additional illumination is by low voltage halogen lights
- Varnished teak handrails in the overhead

- Varnished teak pilothouse dash and upper cabin house sides
- Teak locking companionway door
- Varnished teak handrail is on the aft end of the pilothouse

Additional Amenities:

- Customized Ivory color drop curtains with clear heavy-duty plastic windows provide a fully enclosed pilothouse.
- Ivory colored interior window sun covers for all pilothouse windows.

Forward:

- The pilothouse has the helm to starboard with the passenger/navigator area to port
- Pompanette "Custom Hinckley" Prestige helm and passenger seats on powder on powder coated stainless pedestals, finished in Light Oyster Ultra-Leather, can adjust fore/aft and swivel to face aft. There are stainless steel footrests.

Forward (port):

- The forward port passenger area has a cup holder on the forward bulkhead
- AC/DC electrical panel is outboard and a custom DC outlet is nearby
- There is a goose-neck chartlight in this area

Helm Station (starboard)

• The helm station has a a varnished teak instrument pod with continuing shelf outboard and aft, stainless steel 14" steering wheel with varnished wood rim, Jet Stick, engine gauges, remote switches to spotlight, and cup holder

Helm Electronics and Navigation Equipment:

- Raytheon ST-6000 Autopilot with rate sensor
- Northstar 962 color 10" GPS/Chartplotter with memory upgrade: Regions 4,6,7.8.9 and 9.1 installed
- Raytheon RL-80C Plus 10.4" Color LCD Radar (interfaced with GPS) with 4-kw pedestal, 48" open array
- Standard Horizon VHF radio/loud hailer
- Raytheon ST-60 Tri-data multi-function display with depth, water temperature, and speed indicator
- Danforth Constellation compass
- GPS/DGPS antenna painted to match deck

Aft Pilothouse:

 Pilothouse aft has additional seating with two (2) curved settees, each with a varnished teak shelf rim outboard that faces inboard and forward and that have back and bottom cushions covered in custom Light Oyster Ultra-Leather

To port:

- Settee can convert to a 6'-7' berth
- There is a locker stowage beneath the settee
- Varnished teak table on a pedestal can be lowered to form a more comfortable berth

To starboard:

Settee can convert to a kids-size berth and has stowarge under.

Pilothouse amenities include:

- SFI 60 icemaker is mounted under the helm seat with varnished teak louvered door access
- Pilothouse sole stowage
- Three (3) 12-volt lights over the settees

INTERIOR ACCOMMODATIONS

From the pilothouse forward and down two companionway steps is the main cabin accommodation. Convenient to the pilothouse are the galley and private head with sleeping accommodations located forward

The interior is finished in satin-varnished cherry, including sheathing and the soft, insulated overhead is white with cherry trim.

- The cabin sole is varnished teak & tulipwood and has a custom cabin sole cover.
- All cabin locker doors are louvered with radius corners on the frames.

Amenities include:

- (3) Opening overhead hatches
- (4) Opening ports below (including head and galley)
- All opening ports and hatches have screens
- Custom interior sun covers for windows and hatches
- Various throw pillows
- Frigast stainless steel 12-volt lamps provide plenty of interior lighting.
- Two MarineAir reverse-cycle heat/air conditioning units with outlets in the main cabin, galley, head, and pilothouse.

Entertainment electronics:

Alpine FM/Cassette stereo with 6-CD changer, amplifier and six (6) Alpine speakers
(2) on forward bulkhead, (2) in pilothouse overhead, (2) aft in cockpit.

GALLEY (Starboard)Immediately starboard of the companionway is the galley:

- The varnished cherry galley has a Savannah Corian countertop.
- Polished stainless steel sink has Grohe fixtures, spray nozzle, and hot and cold pressure water.
- Seaward electric 4-burner cooktop stove
- Sharp R820BK microwave/convection oven
- Grunert Polarmate 12-volt DC refrigeration/freezer.

A varnished cherry pantry with louvered doors and several shelves separates the galley from the V-berth area. The offset forward sink is integral mounted in the Corian countertop. Next to the sink is a countertop accessed waste bin. Next aft is the built-in stove-top with the microwave/convection oven built in behind a cherry door beneath the stove. Built in on the aft bulkhead, the refrigeration is top-accessed through the countertop.

- Stowage is located in the pantry, outboard and under the sink, outboard the stove, and over outboard the refrigeration.
- 12-volt light is mounted under the locker over the refrigeration
- Halogen spotlight is over the galley area.

Galley amenities include:

- Proper stowage for 6 settings of tableware
- 110-volt GFI outlet
- Red step-light in galley
- Opening port with screen
- Opening overhead hatch adds extra light and ventilation

HEAD (Port):Opposite the galley to port is a private head with a solid cherry door. The molded head sole has nonskid molded in.

- Savannah Corian countertop has an undermounted sink.
- Separate shower area with custom handheld shower fixture with shut-off has a ? hands-free? mounting bracket.
- Grohe fixture provides hot & cold pressure water.
- Sealand Vacu-flush ?bone color? marine head is plumbed directly to the holding tank.
- 110-volt GFI outlet
- Recessed halogen lights over sink.
- Dome lights in shower stall
- Storage is provided by cherry faced lockers above and outboard the vanity and a locker under the vanity.

- Forced ventilation
- Opening port with screen.
- Opening overhead hatch adds extra light and ventilation

SLEEP ACCOMMODATIONS (Forward): Sleeps two forward in V-BERTH with adapter to form a Double berth:

- Cushions are upholstered in Navy Ralph Lauren tapestry fabric.
- (2) Matching pillow shams with Indigo piping.
- Locker storage is under the V-berths with easy access cherry drop front doors.
- Forward of the V-berth is additional storage with shelves behind louvered cherry doors.

Aft of the V-berth to port is a cushioned seat covered in matching Navy Ralph Lauren tapestry fabric. Outboard is a cedar-lined hanging locker with a shelf over. Starboard, another cedar-lined hanging locker has shelves outboard and hanging storage inboard. There is shelf storage over both hanging lockers.

- Two stereo speakers are mounted port and starboard on the forward bulkhead.
- Opening overhead hatch

MOOSE MAPLE II was totally re-powered in 2015 at Bird Yacht Services.

- Side and rear curtains which attach to the Bimini to totally enclose the cockpit
- Plastic tile decking for the cockpit
- Heavy gauge plastic on rear pilothouse curtains
- Covers for all exterior brightwork
- New bottom paint
- Varnished exterior brightwork
- Jets serviced and painted
- Boat cleaned inside and out including swim platform oiled

- New generator solenoid
- New bow thruster zinc anode
- New charging systems relays and Balmar regulator
- Northstar Chartplotter upgraded memory and software
- Windshield washer wiper system totally overhauled
