Summary of Accommodation:

- The accommodation is fitted out in teak to a very high standard and offers up to eight berths in three cabins with full standing headroom; there is plentiful stowage throughout.
- Upholstered throughout.
- In the forecabin, large sail stowage space with fixed bunks over.
- Large opening hatch to foredeck.
- Separate heads compartment to starboard with marine toilet, shower and washbasin.
- Extractor fan.
- Hanging lockers opposite.
- In saloon, two settee berths with deep comfortable upholstery.
- Lee cloths.
- Pilot berth outboard to starboard.
- Fixed table with drop leaves.
- The saloon has been modified to replace the port pilot berth with a locker and bookcase.
- This could easily be reinstated.

- Chart table to starboard with galley opposite.
- Walk through to aft cabin aft of the chart table.
- Single berth to starboard with double berth opposite.
- Occasional seat.
- Hanging locker.
