The amazing design includes a three stateroom-three head layout, large salon and fabulous galley. Lady Galathea does not show her age in any respect and deserves serious consideration. Huge lazarette and walk-in engine room with accessibility to all piping and wiring which is all marked and uniformly placed in the cable trays. Sewer Treatment Plant. A proper furnace for those Arctic and Alaskan winter cruises, protected rudders and propellers. Serious stability with Koop Nautic stabilizers. The simplicity but comfort of the teak interior. Redundant electronics and there is much much more to discover.....

ACCOMMODATIONS AND LAYOUT

Lady Galathea sleeps six in three cabins with ensuite heads. The interior joiner work is beautifully crafted teak finished with a satin varnish. Cabin soles are varnished teak and holly throughout, marble tile flooring and Corian countertops in the heads. Lady Galathea is tastefully decorated throughout with newly upholstered salon settee and all new overhead panels throughout the vessel in May 2013. All new wall coverings in staterooms in 2013.

MAIN SALON

Entering from the aft deck through a large sliding glass door there is an L-shaped settee to port with varnished teak table with two folding leaves creating a dining table that easily seats 6. Opposite is console cabinet with entertainment system and storage. To port aft is a writing desk and book shelves. Additionally there is: • Window shades that open from the top or bottom • Two opening side windows • Air conditioning • Radiant heat system • Large storage under settee • Teak and holly sole • New ceiling overhead panels • Newly upholstered L-shaped settee • Flat screen TV that rises from cabinet • KVH 5 Sat TV receiver • Stereo system

GALLEY

Up two steps from the main salon is the large U-shaped galley • Granite counter tops • Stainless sink and drainboard • Two undercounter refrigerators • Miele four burner ceramic stove top with overhead vent fan • Miele full sized electric oven • Multiple drawers and cabinets • Espresso/cappuccino machine • Micrwave oven • Large window to port

PILOTHOUSE

The pilothouse is just forward of the galley. There are sliding doors port and starboard giving easy access to the side decks. On the starboard side is a bench seat with storage under. The stairs to the flybridge just aft. Additionally: • Adjustable centerline helm seat with footrest and built-in rudder control • Full electronics and engine instrumentation-updated • Magnetic compass • Windshield wipers with wash • Windshield defrost system • Navigation station with seat and storage under to port • Stairs down to accommodations to starboard forward • Monitor panel with tank gauges and indicator lights

MASTER STATEROOM

The master stateroom is located below forward and has an island queen berth and ensuite head • Two hanging lockers • Multiple drawers and additional storage • Two opening overhead hatches with blackout shades • Two opening port holes with screens and curtains • Reading lights at berth • New A/C unit • Ensuite head includes: Vacuflush head Large shower stall Marble tile floor Corian countertop Heated towel bar Opening porthole with screen and curtain Exhaust vent

PORT GUEST STATEROOM

The port guest stateroom has a queen berth outboard and a desk inboard and ensuite head: • Two hanging lockers • Desk with drawers • Multiple drawers and additional

storage • Reading lights at berth • Opening porthole with screen and curtains • Stereo • Hidden safe in closet • Ensuite head includes: Large shower stall Vacuflush head Heated towel bar Marble tile floor Corian countertop Opening porthole with screen and curtain Drawer and mirrored vanity storage Exhaust vent

STARBOARD GUEST STATEROOM

This stateroom has two single over and under bunks outboard with a cabinet and small desk inboard. There is an ensuite head. • Hanging locker • Two opening portholes with screens and curtains • Additional storage • Ensuite head includes: Vacuflush head Large shower stall Heated towel bar Marble tile floor Corian countertop Opening port with screen and curtain Exhaust fan

FLYBRIDGE

Access the flybridge from the stairs to starboard of the galley. The double overhead hatch allows additional light inside when sliding wooden hatch is open. Forward is a centerline helm with two helm chairs. Just aft and to port is a large L-shaped settee with table. To starboard is a cabinet with built in Bar-B-Que and refrigerator. Further aft is the electric davit and tender. Additionally: • Hinged Radar arch • Helm console with engine instruments and electronics • New Plexiglass windscreen • Bimini top • Propane Grill • New Isotherm Refrigerator/freezer • Large storage space under settee • New Zodiak 340 RIB hard bottom inflatable with 30hp Honda • Life Raft mounted on starboard side • Seat cushions

HULL AND DECK

The displacement hull design has a full keel with skegs protecting the propellers plus bilge keels for added stabilization and an integral swim platform. The hull and deck are steel with an aluminum house structure creating an extremely strong and seaworthy vessel. The aft and side decks are teak over steel. The Portugese bridge provides useful protection and storage. The chain locker is accessed from a watertight Freeman hatch on the foredeck. Oversized bollard style cleats are found fore and aft for secure docking. The rubrails and other potential chafe areas are integral stainless to prevent rust. The aft deck has integrated seating across the transom with a table and storage under. Port and starboard are gates aft lead to the swim platform. There is a large deck hatch giving access to the lazarette room. • Steel bulwarks with stainless railings above • Storage under aft deck seating • Storage in Portugese bridge • Electric warping winch on aft deck • Maxwell 3500 Hydraulic Windlass • 2 Navy type anchors with 300' of 13mm(1/2") chain each, there is a third anchor in the lazarette • Tender davit • Multiple freeing ports • Topsides from waterline up and house were re-painted in 2013/2014

with Dupont Imron paint system, all hardware removed, sandblasted as needed then paint system applied. Further details and records available for prospective buyers to review. • Bottom was completely sandblasted in 2013, acid washed, 3 coats epoxy primer and 2 coats bottom paint applied • Prop speed applied to props, shafts, bow thruster and stabilizers in 2013 • Chain locker was sandblasted and painted in 2013 • Bow thruster
