She was first overall in the 2013 ORR East Coast Championships and won the prestigious Olin Stephens trophy (by chance her design) in 2013 and 2014. The 48 is S&S designed, and is as formidable now as it was in 1972. DREAMCATCHER has had much money spent upgrading in recent years, with a new engine, sails and much more.

- The teak decks were replaced in the mid 80's, and were 50% thicker than Swan's original.
- The toerails have been removed and replaced with teak (2005).

### *Summary of Accommodation:*

- V berth cabin forward with fold up berths, and storage under.
- Next aft is a head to port, with sink and hand held shower.
- The main saloon has a settee to starboard and a U shaped settee to port.
- Both make good seaberths.
- There are pilot berths on both sides, outboard of the settees.



- Drop leaf table on centreline.
- Next aft to port is the U shaped galley, with 3-burner stove, large top and front loaded fridge, and a sink.
- Sliding doors outboard with lockers behind.
- Large navigation table to starboard, with a hanging locker aft.
- Finally, there is a large owner's cabin aft with a double and single, plus an en-suite head.
- The generator is located between the berths and is insulated by both the manufacturer's enclosure and a wooden soundshield.
- Misc. interior hardware, lamps etc. at owner's home.
