She is beautifully finished with a teak transom and deck, and a Bausch Salerno tuna tower with custom blacked out buggy top, tower mounted 21" Rupp outriggers, molded fiberglass hardtop with molded lighting and electronics box. Up top, there is a Furuno 7.1 NavNet Repeater, Icom 412 VHF radio with remote speaker, trim tabs, and digital tach. Power assisted hydraulic wheel steering and blacked out dash with single lever controls complete the package.

A/C panel is by Bass Products, located to starboard. The cabin area is spotless white Awlgrip with centerline aft drain for easy cleaning. Full air conditioning.

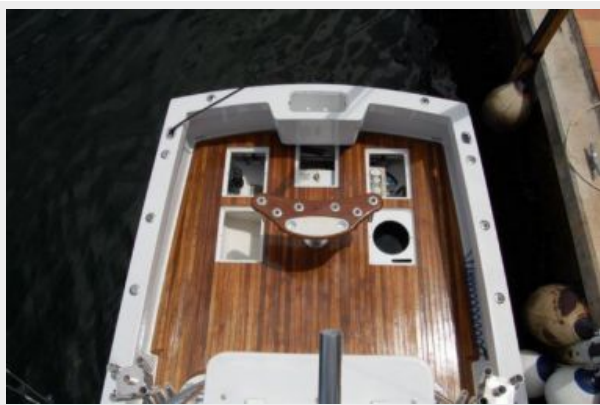
