Overview

FAX OF LIFE represents the best of the classic double cabin designs. Space utilization is excellent; there is ample space for entertaining and there is ample storage available. Moving about FAX OF LIFE is a pleasure due to the use of wide stairs as opposed to step ladders. Her low center of gravity precludes the need for stabilizers, yet she has good turn of speed with only modest horsepower resulting in real economy of operation. She features 5 separate A/C units that ensure cool, comfortable temperatures for the entire vessel including the flybridge and aft deck.

FAX OF LIFE offers a very smooth ride due to updating and alignment of the underwater running gear. In addition, the hull bottom has been barrier coated. Her interior joinery is first-rate: dovetail joints that are typically only found in top quality furniture and high-end yachts. This tastefully furnished and decorated vessel will be appreciated by the yachting community.

- Access via a white aluminum door with large double windows and down four wide teak steps with matching teak railing
- Satin finish, golden teak with off-white carpeting and a white vinyl headliner
- (9) Windows for viewing, with 4 opening windows
- Off-white mini-blinds
- (2) Custom barrel swivel chairs in green leather
- Matching green leather ottoman
- Teak bannister forward separates the salon from the office below
- RCA 25" television/VCR
- Sony 10-disc CD changer
- Sony AM/FM/cassette

Galley

- U-shaped galley to starboard
- Dinette tabletop is glossy-varnished burl, supported by a stainless steel pedestal which can hand-crank down to form a berth platform; dedicated berth cushion/mattress
- Dinette seats 5 guests with ample storage below
- Galley island with sinks and stovetop and dish locker overhead
- Liquor locker in galley island
- Faux dark granite mica countertops
- Double sink in FRP with custom sink cover on one side
- Princess 3-burner Ceran cooktop
- Whirlpool refrigerator/freezer with in-door water and ice dispenser

- Sharp Carousel microwave/convection oven
- Built-in Black & Decker Spacemaker coffeemaker
- Black & Decker toaster oven

Master Stateroom

- Located aft, 3 steps down from salon
- Off-white carpeting
- Centerline berth covered with a green floral print
- Teak aft bulkhead with build-in bookshelves
- Window/escape hatch with teak mini-blinds
- Lighted make-up mirror and vanity with parson's chair
- Sliding/opening windows with green and white drapery
- White mica countertop with drawers providing ample storage
- Full-sized hanging locker
- Samsung 19" television with VCR

Forward Head

- Located aft and starboard of the VIP Stateroom
- Vacuflush head
- Mirrored vanity

- Bi-fold shower door with high threshold
- Teak and holly sole deck and teak floor grating in the shower
- Green Corian vanity with a brass faucet
- 110 VAC duplex outlet
- Access to the shower sump, black water tank and overboard discharge, a/c raw water pump, sea strainer, seacock, electric bilge pump and high water alarm switch, and manual Whale Gusher-type pump located in passageway hatches

Office

- Located across from forward head
- Large desktop area with chair, reading light, and overhead light
- Opening portlight
- Ample space for computer, charts, and other reading materials

- Splendide 2000 wash/dryer (110 VAC) behind aft locker door
- Step to the salon hinges for access to the full-beam engine room

Aft Deck

- Hard-enclosed aft deck
