DETAILED INFORMATION

Walkthrough

This is the best equipped model on the market, offering an abundance of factory and owner-added options. An aft cockpit provides easy boarding and features fully removable canvas and isinglass enclosure. The extended flying bridge overhangs the aft cockpit and also features full canvas enclosure. There is plenty of guest seating on the bridge and it is easily and safely accessed by molded-in stairs from the cockpit. The galley-up interior floorplan is well thought-out and comfortably sleeps four in two private staterooms. The cabin layout also features a spacious head compartment with separate shower stall. Constructed on a modified-V hull with 7.5 degrees of aft deadrise this design also delivers comfortable long range cruising. The exterior hull color is white with black canvas, black accent stripes, and black bottom paint.

Cockpit

Boarding the vessel is made safe and easy by way of a large molded-in aft swim/boarding platform. Here one finds non-skid decking, stainless steel hand-holds, all shore service connections, a fold-out swim ladder, a hot/cold hand-held deck shower, and convenient fuel fills to both tanks. A starboard-side transom door with courtesy lighting leads forward into the cockpit. The cockpit arrangement includes molded-in steps on either side for foredeck access, a large sliding glass cabin entry door, and a relaxed staircase on the starboard side leading up to the flying bridge. The aft cockpit also features overhead cover provided by the upper bridge overhang as well as full canvas enclosure. Two deck hatches open with gas shock assists to expose the lazarette storage compartment. This lazarette compartment is insulated for sound and houses the generator, stern thruster components, batteries, steering gear, and other machinery---lessening the amount of complication in the engine compartment.

Other features of the cockpit include:

- self-bailing
- non-skid decking
- tan snap-down outdoor carpeting
- recessed overhead and courtesy lighting
- storage compartment

Foredeck

Moving to the foredeck is made possible by way of molded-in steps in the cockpit that lead up to sidewalks on either side of the vessel. These narrow sidewalks offer stainless

steel safety railing, well-placed stainless steel hand-holds, and non-skid decking.

Foredeck features include:

- (4) stainless steel fender storage racks
- welded stainless steel railings
- non-skid decking
- low-mounted stainless steel handrails
- black canvas snap-on windshield cover
- 10" stainless steel mooring cleats
- *Lewmar* electric anchor windlass with foredeck foot-switches and helm mounted remote control
- circular Bomar deck hatch

Fly Bridge

The flying bridge is accessed up a relaxed staircase from the starboard side of the cockpit. Arrangement includes a large L-shaped settee situated to port and which can also serve as an aft-facing lounge. The helm station is located forward and to starboard featuring a single adjustable captain's bucket seat. A generous aft overhang provides cover for the cockpit below and additional usable space on the bridge.

Bridge features include:

- tan snap-down outdoor carpeting with non-skid decking beneath
- welded stainless steel railing
- radar arch
- Clarion outdoor stereo speakers
- full black canvas and isinglass enclosure
- drink holders
- courtesy lighting
- smoked plexiglass wrap-around wind deflector
- storage compartments

Helm

The helm station is positioned forward and to starboard on the flying bridge and offers terrific visibility. A removable canvas cover provides service access to within the helm console and the captain is provided an adjustable pedestal bucket seat. This chair features a hinged seat base that lifts to provide an elevated seat post or to serve as a standing bolster.

Salon

The salon is entered from the cockpit through a large tinted sliding glass door on the port side. The airy salon features wrap-around cabin windows which provide plenty of natural light and panoramic water views. The L-shaped galley is located in the salon and positioned along the starboard side and aft. An entertainment center is built into galley cabinets along the aft bulkhead and the power distribution panel is conveniently located to port immediately upon entry. A huge Flexsteel L-shaped sofa extends along the port side of the salon and features dual incliners. This sofa is complimented by a free-standing high/low table that enlarges with fold-out expansion panels. A smaller curved settee is raised and positioned ahead of the galley on the starboard side of the salon. Engine room access is by way of removable hatches in the salon sole and a companionway leads forward and down to the staterooms and head. The interior is decorated with light beige carpeting and beige leather upholstery beautifully contrasted against darker countertops. Cherry woodwork, black & gold accent pillows, and color-coordinated fabric selections complete the interior decor.

Galley

The galley-up floorplan places the galley to the starboard side of the salon and aft. This full-service galley features all the amenities including:

- built-in *Origo* microwave oven
- free-standing *Mr. Coffee* coffee maker
- recessed Princess 2-burner electric single-surface cooktop
- large single-basin stainless steel sink with spray nozzle and recessed cover to enlarge countertop space
- *Norcold* under-counter dual voltage refrigerator/freezer
- abundant lighted cabinet and drawer storage including a Lazy-Susan revolving storage rack
- *Karadon* single-surface countertops

Guest Stateroom

The guest stateroom is situated down and to the starboard side of the vessel. This stateroom closes-off with a hinged wooden privacy door and features a large double berth at floor level.

Other highlights include:

- cedar-lined hanging locker
- opening porthole
- Safe-T-Alert carbon monoxide detector
- padded headliner & wall covering
- access to additional bilge storage and service
- shelf storage
- overhead lighting
- directional reading lights
- under berth storage
- 110-volt outlet

Master Stateroom

The master stateroom is located completely forward in the vessel and features an island-style double berth off-set to starboard. This stateroom also closes-off with a hinged wooden privacy door and offers a large cedar-lined & illuminated hanging locker with shelves.

Other features include:

- single circular overhead deck hatch with screen
- (2) opening portholes with screens
- overhead and directional reading lights
- Safe-T-Alert carbon monoxide detector
- mirrored forward bulkhead
- recessed Toshiba TV/VCR
- 110-volt receptacle
- separate thermostat heat/air conditioning zone
- dressing seat
- shelf/countertop storage
- under-berth storage drawers

Head

The head compartment is located down and to port in the cabin.

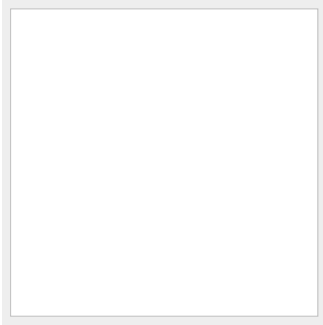

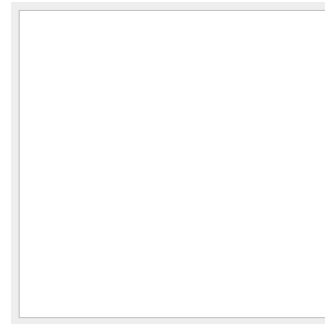

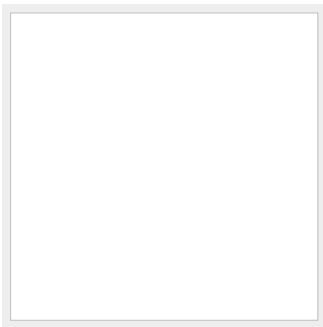
Starboard Bow



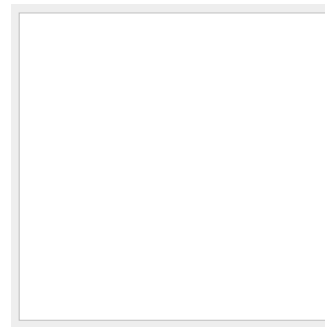

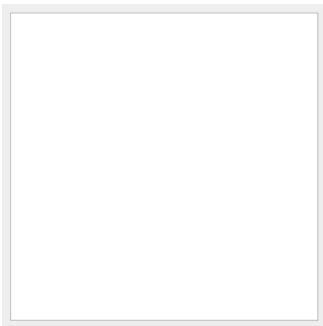

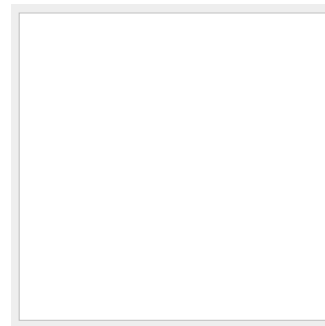
