DETAILED INFORMATION

Construction

RCD Status: The yacht conforms with the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC (Recreational Craft Directive) and is categorised A – “Ocean”

Hull Construction:

- Composite construction with end grain balsa core providing strength, thermal insulation and acoustic insulation.
- Layer of Kevlar adding to the hull strength.
- Non-pigmented gel is used below the waterline to help prevent osmosis.
- Vinylester resins are used throughout for added strength and osmosis prevention.
- 3 x Layers of epoxy as a barrier against moisture ingress.
- Hull Moulding in "Navy Blue", boot top line red over white.
- Cavita line in gel coat in white.
- Antifouling in Seajet red.
- Stainless steel rubbing rail on gunwale by cleats.

Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- Composite construction with end grain balsa core providing strength, thermal insulation and acoustic insulation.
- Marine ply, stainless steel or alloy is used in all load bearing areas for added strength.
- Teak capping rail and decks.
- Joined to the hull with epoxy paste and stainless bolts for security.
- All bulkheads are laminated into the deck for strength and stiffness.

Keel & Rudder:

- 9,500kg (20,500lb) shaped lead keel and a depth of 7'3" (2.23m) provides a ballast ratio of 42% providing maximum stability.
- Semi balanced large Kevlar reinforced rudder.

- 1 x Yanmar 4LHA-HTP 160hp; fresh water cooled.
- Gearbox ratio of 2.68:1.
- Stainless steel Morse control.
- Racor twin fuel filter with alarm.

- 3 x Reading lights in saloon, fitted to saloon forward bulkhead, plus 1 over pilot berth; floor night lights in red.
- 2 x Reading lights fitted to Pullman cabin, plus 2 x in aft cabin, and 2 x in foreward cabin.
- Bendy light fitted to nav. desk – LED red and white.
- Single boom light.
- Hella LED navigation lights, plus tricolor.
- Mast has a 24v deck flood light.

Accommodation

Summary of Accommodation:

- All main saloon windows are double glazed toughened safety glass.
- 2 x Front opening windows in saloon.
- Opening hull ports at galley, pilot berth and in owner's cabin;
- Standard joinery in Cherry.
- Retaining catches on floor hatches.
- 2 x Overhead Lewmar hatches in saloon.
- Cherry/holly 40 x 4mm spacing laminate flooring throughout.
- Corian surfaces in heads and galley; in cream in the galley and pale rose in the heads compartments; with non-standard moulded in hand basins in white corian.
- Full walk-in engine room.
- Lee cloths throughout colour in standard Beige.
- Stainless steel door handles.
- Push button catches in large chrome.
- All doors have inlay in sycamore, madrona and figured cherry to trim.

- 7 Lewmar portlights in coachroof, all opening with flyscreens
- 6 Gebo opening Port lights in hull
- Opening transom port light.
- Forward cabin overhead hatch.
- All overhead hatches incorporate Ocean Sky screens

Note: Wardrobe instead of starboard seat in aft cabin.

Description of layout from forwards:

Main Forward Cabin:

- Alternative layout with head aft, footstools and high level lockers.
- Concealed Shade/Mosquito Screen.
- Ventilation grills fitted to high level locker doors, either side of the forward cabin berth.
- Windscoop for forward hatch.
- 2 x Drawers, wardrobe, shelves and large cupboard.
- Dorade.

Pullman Cabin:

- Upper and lower berth.
- 2 x Hatches, with fly screens.
- Wardrobe forward and shelved cupboard aft
- Drawers; with major drawer storage beneath bunks.
- Reading lights for both bunks.

Heads Compartment:

- 220v electric heated towel rails.
- Electric WC – fresh/salt water (switchable)
- Separate shower compartment.

Saloon:

- Centre of saloon table has insert so that it is flush when folded up, item covered in baize to prevent it from damaging the table top.
- Saloon table top open with compass rose, burr madrona veneer with sycamore inlay and cherry cross banded edge.
- Canvas cover for table.
- Magazine slot fitted to forward saloon seating, including lid with finger hole.
- Concealed Sky screens (shade/Mosquito) to both Saloon coach roof hatches.
- Navigation desk in standard pod arrangement.
- Bookshelf fitted behind centre saloon seating forward bulkhead.
- Lockers fitted outboard of navigation desk.
- Grab handles fitted on navigation desk inboard face, ceiling and companionway
- Lee cloth to starboard saloon sofa/pilot berth.
- Foot locker under trotter box cushion in saloon.
- Drinks cabinet in table support. Wine storage locker

Note: TV on motorized mechanism, hides behind sofa when not in use.

Navigation Area:

- Barolo Clock and barometer.
- Protection for navigation seat.

Galley:

- Cup rack mounted at aft end of galley – 2 x stack of mugs and tumblers.
- Larder with 4 x basket drawers.
- Double drainer stainless steel sinks
- Corian Dump sink
- Removable Corian covers for sinks
- Separate chopping board to fit over main sink
- 3 x Drawers fitted under dump sink, 1 x large and 2 x small.
- Microwave
- 4 burner cooker with extractor fan over
- Under floor storage

Aft Cabin:

- 2 x wardrobes in aft cabin
- 1 x Additional shelf in locker – port locker (shoe shelf low level).
- Bookshelves in aft cabin, below port lights port and starboard.
- Aft section of aft cabin wardrobes are opening to create extra storage.
- Centreline Kingsize berth (6'6" long, 5'9" wide)
- Sprung mattress for comfort

Ensuite Heads:

Cockpit

- Deep centre cockpit for safety and comfort.
- Large drains to remove water quickly with steel grating to stop smaller items being lost.

- Substantial teak cockpit table with drinks holders.

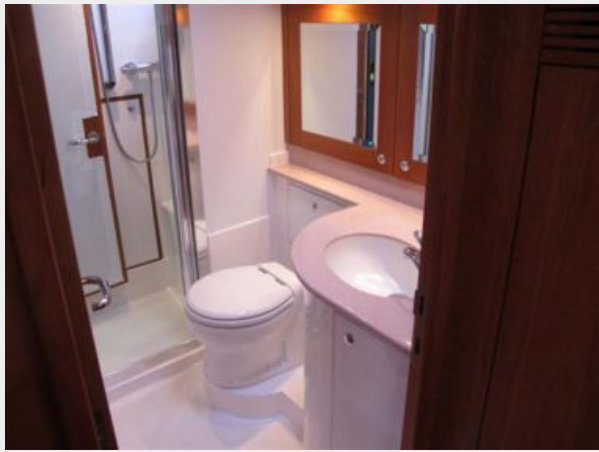


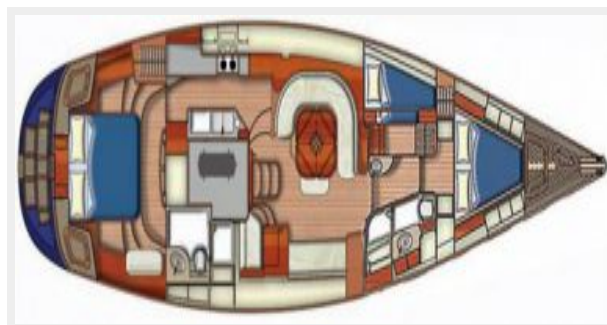
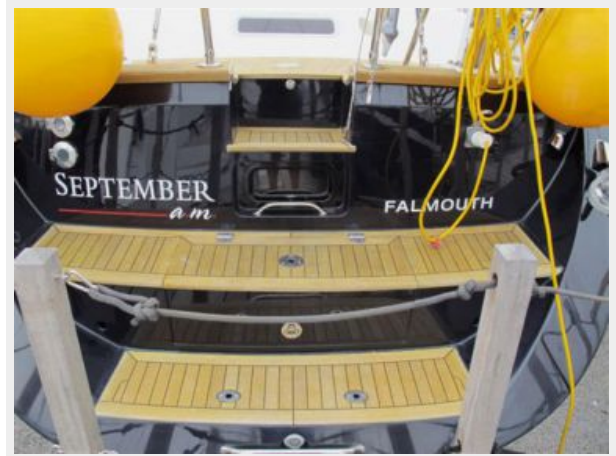
