DETAILED INFORMATION

BROKER REMARKS

Classic Hunt Harrier 25 with Flag Blue topsides, double red boot stripe and green bottom. Drop dead gorgeous lines. Reinforced bimini bow and full enclosure. Brand new Volvo Ocean X stern drive installed by Hunt. Recent sea trial by Hunt Service confirms she runs great. Bow thruster and Garmin 10" GPS plotter/sounder. Owner too busy to use. Won't last long!

HULL

- Flag Blue topsides with double red boot stripe and green bottom. White Gelcoat decks with contrasting cream non-skid
- Solid E-glass bottom laminate
- E-glass topsides laminate with closed cell (non-water absorbing) foam-cored sandwich construction
- (4) Full-length longitudinal E-glass over closed-cell (non water-absorbing) foam stringers in hull bilge. Solid glass with steel flat stock within glass lay-up under full length of engine to help secure engine mounts firmly in place
- Vinylester osmosis barrier
- Foam-cored E-glass bulkheads
- Epoxy painted bilge
- Extruded vinyl sheer guard with stainless half-round striker protection
- Molded interior fiberglass pan liner and headliner

DECK

- Deck: E-glass fabric with closed-cell (non water-absorbing) foam-cored laminate and molded non-skid pattern
- Anchor locker: Molded into foredeck with hinged hatch (drains overboard)
- Anchor: 14 lb. Delta with 15' x ¼" chain, 200' x ½" rode
- Handrails: (2) S/S foredeck handrails: (1) on each side of Lewmar foredeck hatch

- (4) Wichard fender pad eyes: (2) port and (2) starboard
- Deck fills: S/S water, fuel and waste deck fills
- Rod holders: in cockpit coamings
- Stern eyes: (2) S/S tow eyes
- (5) Drink holders: (1) at helm, (2) portside and (2) on engine box
- (2) Transom lockers, molded into top of transom with internal drains
- Aft stern seat, 3-piece (removable)
- Transom seat cover

CABIN

- Access: Teak companionway doors (varnished)
- Companionway cover (for teak companionway)
- Berths: V-berth with storage compartments under, and access to bow thruster
- Interior cushions Nantucket Red, self-piped
- Head: Manual saltwater head with Y-valve and holding tank with deck pump-out fitting
- Lighting: S/S dome light
- Storage: Cabinet locker to port
- Cabin sole of faux water-resistant teak and holly
- Interior: Molded fiberglass floor pan and headliner, with natural teak fiddled shelves above V-berth

BRIDGEDECK and COCKPIT

- Bimini top: Reinforced S/S bimini bow with bridge deck light, all-around light, radar pod and S/S handholds (port/starboard sides) with cream Stamoid, side curtains and front filler curtain. Three-piece, clear vinyl stern curtains
- Teak table varnished bright with removable covers. Cream Stamoid covers for:
 Port side dash varnished teak glove box; varnished engine instrument pod;
 varnished helm electrical panel; dual helm side glove boxes; wet bar top fiddle
- Helm: Molded fiberglass helm control console with varnished teak trim and engine instrument cluster; custom wood steering wheel with Hunt logo
- 12 V Hella fan at helm
- Compass: Ritchie (high speed)
- Seating: Adjustable sport helm seat with drop-down cabinet storage beneath; adjustable sport companion seat with fold-down foot rest and locker beneath; Lsettee wraps around to engine box with removable backrest

- Exterior cushion fabric: Cream vinyl with perforated center panels and dark blue piping
- Cockpit refrigerator with S/S face
- Drainage: Self-bailing cockpit with guttered hatches
- Shower: Hot and cold pressure water shower on port side transom
- Lighting: (2) LED courtesy bridgedeck foot lights and (2) LED courtesy cockpit foot lights
- Self-contained salt water deck wash (washdown) with compact coiled hose/nozzle in tube within port side boarding step
- Natural solid teak tops on both port and starboard boarding steps

- Engine: Volvo Penta EVC 8.1 liter gas (375 hp) fresh water cooled with salt water heat exchanger with jackshaft/ upgraded Volvo Ocean X stern drive
- (2) S/S, 3-blade, counter-rotating propellers

- Electric bow thruster with dash joystick control
- Cooling: Salt water sea strainer in lieu of raw water intake through lower stern drive unit, seacock with thru-hull intake
- (2) Automatic bilge pumps: (1) 1,100 gph, aft, and (1) 750 gph, midships
- (2) Fuel tanks, 50 gallons each
- Water tank, 15 gallons
- Horn: AFI flush-mount 12-volt electric air horn

- (2) 12-volt Batteries, marine-grade, transom-mounted rotary switch with parallel battery capability
- 10-amp Battery charger (for trickle charging) with plug within starboard side step and outdoor 12 gauge extension cord
- House start battery with parallel switch on transom
- Engine start battery with parallel switch on transom
- 12-volt Electrical outlet at helm within side teak storage compartment

- VHF radio
- S/S whip antenna and GPS mount on double bow
- Clarion AM/FM/6-CD changer with (4) remote speakers and helm remote control


