DETAILED INFORMATION

Write Up

An imposing yacht with world-class amenities, the Ocean Alexander 548 will appeal to upscale buyers looking for a well built long-range cruiser from a top-tier builder. A broad 17'9" beam provides this yacht with a tremendous amount of living space. Her split-level interior begins with a spacious salon with sectional sofa, wet bar, entertainment center, and high-gloss teak paneling and cabinets. The pilothouse, three steps up from the salon, boasts a large U-shaped galley spacious counters, subzero full size refrigerator, and garbage disposal, U-shaped dinette to port, and a starboard helm position with excellent outside visibility. The inside flybridge open staircase is aft of the dining area—a feature not always found in a boat this size. There are three staterooms and two full heads below including an opulent master with queen-size berth, and an equally impressive VIP stateroom forward with queen berth. The spacious walk-in engine room with standing headroom has a pair of 725 HP Yanmars with a cruising speed of 18 knots (+20 knots top). Wide side decks and a large cockpit with transom door and lazarette storage under are a plus.

The well-lit and spacious salon is reached through the aft sliding door. With warm teak paneling and walk behind wet bar it provides the optimum setting for entertaining guests or just spending a quiet evening reading as the sun sets over your favorite anchorage.

GALLEY; (Starboard side behind helm station)

The main deck galley is exceptionally large with plenty of light and great working space in which to prepare and serve those wonderful onboard meals. A convenient galley pass through into salon is great for entertaining. The layout provides an exceptional amount of storage with 9 drawers, 9 cabinets and a dry locker under a Corian counter top. Port and starboard doors provide easy access to the wide side decks.

With the option of a private head with shower stall, your friends or family will love the privacy afforded to the VIP forward suite. Going down to the master suite,, you pass the Miehle washer and dryer

Guest Stateroom (port side)

There is a guest stateroom down the steps on the port side. with 2 bunks beds.

The roomy guest head has a large vanity and large sink with Grohe faucet. There is storage under the vanity as well as a medicine cabinet. The separate shower stall has a bench seat and temperature control faucet. The head is a Head Hunter Royal Flush with porcelain bowl.

Master Head:

The spacious master head has a sink, mirrored medicine cabinet and large vanity with storage under. Grohe faucet, separate shower w/ bench seat with temperature control Grohe faucet. The head is a Head Hunter Royal flush with porcelain bowl.

Pilothouse

The pilothouse helm area is well laid out with good visibility, along with easy access to the forward and aft cabins, wide side decks by port and starboard access doors and fly bridge access via an open staircase .. The pilot house is equipped with full instrumentation with access to all system controls.

Fly Bridge

Accessible from the internal stairs from the Pilot House , the fly bridge provides a panoramic view for the boat operation and sightseeing. Covered with a hard top (with canvas extension) and fully enclosed sides that open, you are fully protected from the cold morning air or open up for the exhilaration of the wind blowing through your hair while on a fast passage. In the morning this is the perfect place to have a cup of coffee and watch the sun come up. Underway the visibility forward, abeam and aft instills confidence in the safe operation of the boat. The forward helm has a center steering station with storage, two cushioned captain helm chairs, a large L-shaped settee with under seat storage to port, large table, settee to starboard, and refrigeration.

The aft bridge deck house a 11" Boston Whaler Sport, 25 HP Mercury outboard and davit. Motor and cable new in 2013

Cockpit and Deck Area

The spacious cockpit, side and fore decks allow for easy movement around the boat and safe handling of dock lines and ground tackle. In the evening the aft cockpit is a great place to sit with a glass of your favorite wine while grilling your favorite food on the built in electric grill. You board Tortuga either by the mid-ship Marquipt boarding stairs or through the transom doorway via the wide swim platform.
