DETAILED INFORMATION

Builder's Comments

The Hallberg-Rassy 34 was built from 1990 until 2005 in 500 units. HR 34 with her efficient keel and sturdy fractional rig shows sailing characteristics that should not be possible for a fine cruising boat like this. She has won many races, although she at the same time offers great comfort for cruising long distances. The vast 2.24 m aft cockpit is well protected from the sea by the Hallberg-Rassy typical wind screen. All halyard and reefing lines are controlled from the cockpit.

Construction

RCD Status: Pre – RCD

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- Gelcoat colour: Ivory.
- Laminate construction of Hull: isophthalic gelcoat and isophthalic polyester resin is used.
- Hand lay-up method, insulated above water line against heat and cold.
- Integrated rubbing strake with brass strip.
- Blue decorative band in gelcoat.
- Strong floor reinforcements.
- Deep bilge.
- The yacht has a bolt on lead keel with 10 stainless keel bolts.
- Deck and coach roof areas and also cockpit are of sandwich construction laminated to the hull to form a one piece construction.
- Cockpit length 2.24 m.
- Side decks, toe rail, handrails in solid teak.
- Cockpit seats, bathing platform, cockpit floor and side trims in solid teak.

Machinery

Engine & Gearboxes:

- 1 x Volvo Penta 3-cylinder 2030 28hp marine diesel engine, fresh water cooled.
- Engine hours counter.
- Engine has 1100 hours.

Maintenance & Performance:

- Date of last service: March 2015.

Propulsion & Steering:

- Wheel steering with leather covered steering wheel.
- Sail drive with 3-bladed Volvo folding bronze propeller.
- Emergency tiller steering system.

- International navigation lights.
- Combined tricolour/anchor light at masthead.
- Deck light.

Accommodation

Summary of Accommodation:

- Interior in mahogany with matt silk varnish finish.
- High quality upholstery in pale blue.
- Curtains to all portlights and ceiling hatches.
- Grey carpet throughout.
- Floors in varnished teak with inlaid holly stripes.
- Ivory headlining accentuated with mahogany inlays.

*Description of layout from forwards:**Forward Cabin:*

- Double berth 2.03m long and 2.04m wide at the widest part.
- Stowage below berths and lockers above on both sides.
- Hanging locker on port side and various lockers with vanity unit on starboard side.
- Door leading to saloon.

Saloon:

- Straight starboard side settee berth (2.16m long). L-shaped settee berth to port (1.84m long).
- Lockers and bookshelves above the stowage space behind lift-up seatbacks.

- Additional stowage under starboard settee.
- Drop leaf saloon table with bottle stowage.
- Headroom 1.86m.

Galley:

- Stowage for kitchen utensils, chopping board, drawers for cutlery etc. and waste bin.
- Window above the galley.

Chart Table:

- Chart table with lift up seat.
- Stowage below for tools, etc.
- Instrument shelf.
- Electric switch panel with voltmeter, fuel and water gauges, and domestic ammeter.

Aft Cabin:

- 2.13m long berth, 1.66m wide at widest part.
- Hanging locker with additional lockers above berth and stowage below.
- Door leading to saloon.
- Three opening portholes for good light and ventilation.

Heads Compartment:

- Interior lining and cupboard in white matt laminate.
- Shower stall with teak grating.
- Manual pump action WC.
- China wash basin with stowage above and below.
- Mirror.

- Two opening portholes for ventilation.

Deck Equipment

Rig:

- Fractional rig by Selden with backstay tensioner.
- Selden Furlex headsail furling and reefing system.
- Frederiksen ball slide system for mainsail cars.
- Forward and after lower shrouds with double spreaders.
- Halyards and control lines are led back to cockpit.
- 8 x Jammers to 2 x Lewmar 16 winches under the wind shield.
- Main boom supplied with outhaul and 2 x reefing lines.
- Single line reefing system to the cockpit.
- Selden rodkicker.
- Aluminium protective tubes for rigging screws.
- Spinnaker pole track.

Winches:

- 2 x Lewmar 44CST self-tailing sheet winches.

Sails:

- Fully battened mainsail from Sanders Sails with lazyjacks.
- Furling 130% genoa from Sanders Sails.

General:

- Stainless steel pulpit, pushpit, stanchions and guard wires.

Anchoring & Mooring Equipment:

- Mooring cleats forward, aft and amidships.
- Stemhead fitting with bow roller.
- Danforth anchor with chain and line.
- CQR kedge anchor

Covers, Canvas & Cushions:

- Stakpak for main.
- Windscreen with opening centre section, handholds and sprayhood.
- Sprayhood extension to cover entire cockpit.
- Wheel cover and dodgers.
- Winter cockpit cover – used as alternative to bimini.

Tender & Outboard:

- Avon inflatable.
- Mariner 2.5hp outboard with cover.

Safety Equipment:

- 2 x Harness attachment points in cockpit.
- Horseshoe lifebuoy.
- Firdell Blipper radar reflector.
- Oscar man overboard recovery system.

Fire-fighting equipment:

- 3 x Fire extinguishers.

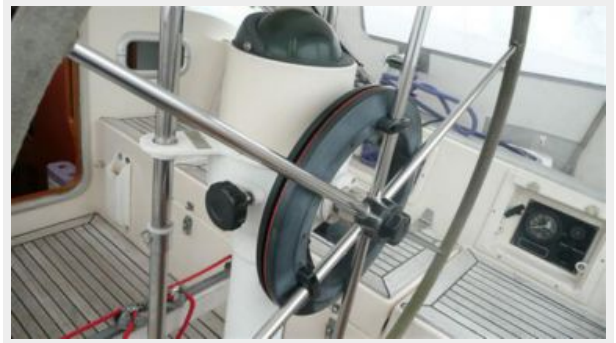

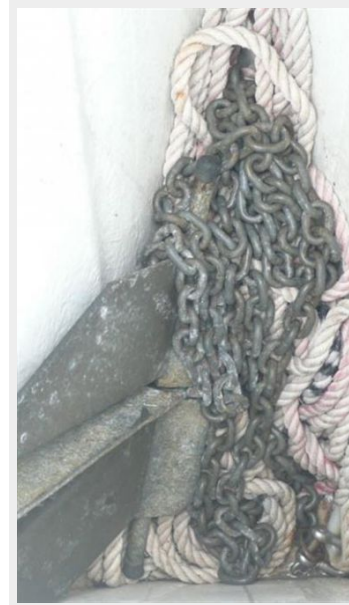
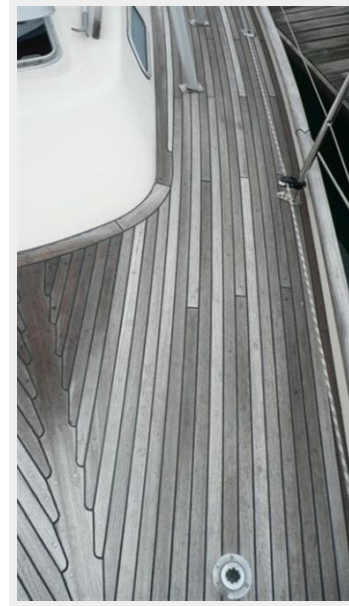
