

## **SPECIFICATIONS**

### **Overview**

Extended cruising in luxury and safety is the basic concept for an Outer Reef Yacht. All Outer Reef Yachts are built to open Ocean Category "A" (wave heights 18-20' and sustained winds of over 40 knots. This 65' Outer Reef is a true bluewater cruiser, powered for fuel economy and long range.

#### **TANKAGE**

- Fuel 9463 litres
- 2 wing tanks in engine room 3217 litres each
- 1 forward fuel tank 3028
- Tank Aluminium
- Water 1514 litres in one central tank
- Tank Stainless steel
- Holding Tank 378 litres in 1 GRP tank
- Fuel and water tanks are monitored by Tank Tender, holding tank uses Tankwatch
  4 monitoring system

#### MECHANICAL/SYSTEMS

- Twin Caterpillar C-9 (1321 hours each) diesel engines 503 BHP at 2500 rpm
- 2 x 12v start banks, one for each engine with parallel capability and charged via Victron Centaur charger
- Glendinning electronic engine controls in pilothouse and flybridge + remote control on umbilical cord allowing full engine and thruster control from any part of the boat
- Back up engine control
- Gear boxes Twin Disc MG-5075A x 2
- Propellers ZF 35" diameter 4 blade manufactured and maintained to S class
- Steering Hynautics hydraulic steering
- TRAC 220 stabiliser system with 7.5 sq ft fins driven by duel Rexroth gearbox mounted hydraulic pumps
- American Bow Thruster hydraulic bow thruster with proportional control
- Side Power electric tunnel stern thruster
- 2 x Onan 17.5KVA MDBKR generators 240v @ 50hz (1390 hours each)
- HRO water maker capable of 240 litres per hour with integrated fresh water flush and pilot house control panel + inline media filter with back flush to protect filters
- 1500lb Brower davit with extendable tip for launch and retrieval of tender from flybridge
- Cruiseair tempered water air conditioning system featuring twin compressor run chilled water circuit running 9 air handlers throughout, with LCD control screens in

each cabin/area, the system is capable of heating, cooling and de-humidfying

• Fireboy engine room fire suppression system including automatic air and engine shut down

#### ACCOMMODATIONS AND LAYOUT

- 9 berths in 4 cabins
- Double guest cabin forward with shared day head and shower (duel access)
- Triple cabin to port with two singles + one overhead berth and private head/shower
- Master Guest cabin with island queen to starboard, his and her wardrobes, private head/and shower
- The master cabin has direct access to the engine room with double door space for sound insulation.
- Crew twin bunks in lazerette with head, basin and vanity
- Each bed is fitted with custom made bed linen, duvets and covers

#### MAIN DECK

- Entry to the salon is via the aft deck double doors. A 5 seat settee with return, height adjustable dining table and ottomans and 3-seat breakfast bar
- Moving forward to the large well appointed galley, then on to the pilot house with separating door
- The pilothouse features a single STIDD helm chair upholstered in leather with banquette and table
- From the pilot house stairs lead down to the accommodation deck or upstairs to the flybridge

#### **FLYBRIDGE**

- The fly bridge features twin Nautihide STDD helm chairs
- Sliding adjustable table is to starboard with a large fold out table (with additional leaves) to port
- All instrumentation is fully functional from the flybridge including autopilot, engine controls, bow/stern thrusters and full navigation data display through the Raymarine E120 screen
- The tender of up to 4m sits centered on its cradle with room for a second tender offset to starboard
- 1500 lb Brower davit to port with extendable tip and cordless control
- Bar fridge, ice maker, stainless steel BBQ and sink with hot and cold water
- Access to the hard top is via stainless steel ladder which is stowed under the fly bridge dash when not required

#### **LAZARETTE**

Accessed via either one of the aft deck stair cases to the marlin board here a

water tight door leads first to the crew area then into the engine room

- The lazarette contains an enclosed cabin with twin bunks, a separate head, sink and a vanity with mirror is to starboard
- Tools and equipment are stowed in cupboard space to starboard

#### **ELECTRICAL**

- Glendinning cable master shore power cable with 240v 50 amp single phase connection
- Main electrical distribution panel with gauges and circuit breakers for 240v/24/12v circuits and remote generator start/shut down and readouts in pilot house
- Separate generator start batteries with parallel capability, charged via the Victron Centaur battery charger
- House bank of service batteries with 740AH capable of running "quiet ship" overnight. These are charged by alternators, a Victron Skylla I charger or the Xantrex inverter charger.
- Xantrex 3kw inverter with 100amp charging capability to service batteries
- Copper bonding to all underwater fittings and shafts with zinc anodes
- Cantalupi lighting fixtures through out including underwater lights on transom
- Vimar light switch panels and dimmers throughout
- Kalenburg dual trumpet air horn with air compressor

#### **GALLEY AND APPLIANCES**

- Large double door stainless steel Leibherr Fridge, freezer and ice maker
- Under counter Leibherr premium freezer
- Insinkerator waste compactor and sink disposal
- Miele 4 hob induction cook top
- Miele oven, dishwasher, convection microwave, rangehood with ducting
- Twin stainless steel sinks with Grohe tap ware
- Stainless steel inbuilt gas BBQ on flybridge
- NEC bar fridge located on flybridge
- NEIS ice maker on flybridge
- Miele washer and separate dryer

### **BROKER'S REMARKS**

CUNEO was built to required Australian standards, and is a one owner yacht whose owner and family have a long history of yacht ownership. She has traveled from Australia to New Zealand and back and has exceptional range and sea keeping abilities. Her owner keeps the yacht in exceptional condition with a full time captain, and is strongly considering a much larger Outer Reef new build after his very positive experience with his 65' Outer Reef.

Duties have been paid both in Australia and New Zealand.
