DETAILED INFORMATION

Accommodations

Separate forward cabin with large V-berth, hanging locker and storage. Next aft starboard is second guest cabin with upper/lower berths.....a head and separate shower is across to port. Next aft is a very comfortable main salon with two large L-shaped settees(port and starboard) and a dining table with seating for six. The rich teak wood is warm and inviting throughout the interior, including teak bulkheads and cabinetry, teak and holly sole, 6'7" headroom, two barrel chairs, convertible settee, large nav station, and light and ventilation provided by the spacious raised salon with surrounding over-sized ports, nine opening hatches, and smaller ports. Aft to port is large sit-down chart table, and across to starboard is large in-line galley with passageway aft to washer/dryer, and into a full width owner's stateroom with queen berth, several hanging lockers and separate head with enclosed shower stall.

Galley

Aft to starboard is a large U-Shaped and walk-through galley, with large counters, overhead storage cabinets, and large pantry. Deep double stainless steel sink with single lever hot/cold mixer faucet, manual freshwater foot pump. Three burner stainless steel gimbaled propane stove with oven, microwave and trash-compacter. A 7.5 cu.ft. molded fiberglass-top loading freezer, with 4" foam insulation, and insulated double lid's. Also a separate full-size standing refrigerator. Storage cabinet with sliding doors surround galley top and under counters. Two 3-drawer bank, under sink storage locker, plate storage, locker.

Hull and Deck

Hull, deck and interior components molded in Irwin Lt gray gel coat. Decks molded with light gray deck, with teak over-lay. Hull is foamed cored above the water line, to stiffen laminate and provide added insulation Thru-bolted bronze seacocks on all thru-hulls below waterline Laminates were carefully scheduled, pattern cut and applied layers of gel coat, laminating polyester resins, glass mat and 24 oz. woven roving or bi-axle glass fiber Horizontal deck surfaces are cored for added stiffness and insulation Hull-to-deck joint by deck overlap of interior hull flange with both chemical and mechanical bonding. 60lb. CQR Anchor , with 180' chain. 45 lb. CQR with 30' chain and 200' rode. Custom welded stainless steel double bow and stern pulpits, with running light mounts Vinyl covered 5/16" stainless steel double lifelines Stainless steel stanchions installed Irwin socket system Lifeline gates port and starboard Stainless steel mast pulpit Gate in stern rail Divided anchor rode locker with chromed bronze deck pipe Welded aluminum bowsprit with stainless steel rod bobstay (2) Metal anchor rollers. Dingy Davits Deck storage aft with hinged deck hatch LPG locker with hinged deck hatch includes two propane tanks Chromed bronze water, fuel, waste deck fittings (4) 12" aluminum cleats, (2) 9" cleats Teak toe rails Cabin top grab rail Drip molding Barbeque grill mounted on stern Fresh water deck wash Modified long keel with cast lead ballast secured and sealed inside molded fiberglass keel. 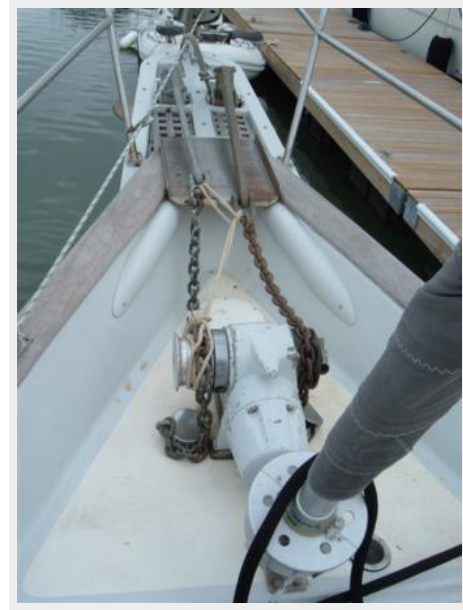
