Construction

RCD Status: Our understanding is that the yacht is exempt from the essential safety requirements of Directive 94/25EC (Recreational Craft Directive) as she was built and placed into use within the EU prior to 1998.

Hull, Deck & Superstructure Construction:

- GRP hull and deck construction.
- GRP non-slip decks.
- White gelcoat hull.
- Preventative epoxy system applied to hull in 2008.
- Teak laid cockpit seating with teak cockpit grating.

Keel & Rudder:

- Iron fin keel externally bolted.
- Balanced GRP rudder blade connected to wheel steering in cockpit.

Machinery

Engine & Gearboxes:

- Perkins Prima M50 4-cylinder, direct-injection, naturally aspirated 49hp diesel engine.
- Freshwater cooling system via raw water intake and heat exchanger.
- Hurth HBW 10/2R reduction gearbox.

Maintenance & Performance:

- Cruising Speed: 6 knots.

Propulsion & Steering:

- Stainless steel propeller shaft connected to gearbox via Vetus flexible coupling.

Plumbing Systems

- Hot water supply via engine calorifier and 220vAC immersion heater element in 25 litre Isotemp hot water tank powered by shorepower.

- 12vDC electric bilge pump (also discharging greywater from shore sump).

- 1 x Stainless steel fuel tank located beneath aft berth with 150 litres.

- 3 x GRP fresh water tanks located beneath saloon seating and under forward berth, with combined capacity of 450 litres.

Grey/Blackwater holding tanks:

- Heads discharge outboard.
- The shower and sinks discharge directly outboard.

Accommodation

Summary of Accommodation:

- Up to seven berths in two double cabins with saloon seats converting to single berths.
- Interior joinery in teak with satin varnish.
- Teak doors and trim.
- Teak and holly solid floors with satin varnish.
- Light blue alcantara upholstery in saloon.
- Luxury mattresses in aft cabin with sprung slats.
- Cream vinyl headlinings throughout and on exposed hull sides where there is no teak trim.
- Solid teak handrails throughout the interior for easy movement offshore.
- Epoxy sealed end grains and sub flooring.
- Pipe cot in saloon.

Description of layout from forwards:

Forward Cabin:

- Double V-berth with hanging locker and storage.

En-suite Heads Compartment:

- Manual marine WC and hand held shower.

Main Saloon:

- U-shaped dinette with centre line drop leaf table.
- Saloon settees can sleep 2-singles.

Galley:

- U-shaped galley 3-burner stove with oven, double stainless steel sinks with hot and cold water, top loading cold pack refrigeration system.

Navigation Station:

- Chart table with navigator's light, instruments and seat.

Aft Heads Compartment:

- Manual marine toilet, vanity sink with hot/cold water and hand held shower.

Aft Cabin:

- Owner's aft cabin with settee bench, cupboards and hanging locker. Access to en-suite head.

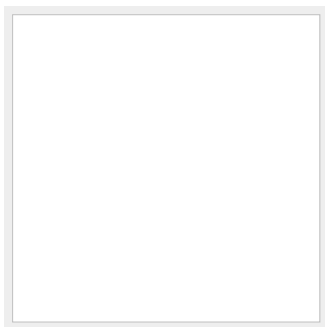

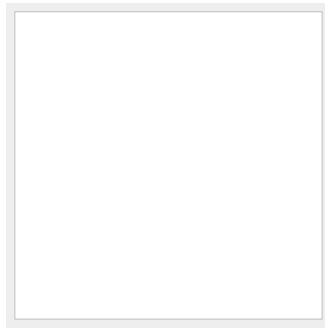
