This is a great opportunity of own a 42 foot Sea Ray at a fraction of the new boat price, in great condition. It can be for a first-time boat owner since it is so easy to handle in tight spaces with its two engines and bow thruster. Not only can you turn on a dime, but you can swing the bow into your slip like it's a video game.

Or, this 42 footer can be an upgrade for someone looking for comfort for the entire family to spend the night at anchor, watching a movie or even TV with a satellite system.

Why is this couple selling their boat so soon? So many frequent family visitors calls for a larger boat!

## Accommodations

---

The Forward Owner's Cabin offers the comfort of an island queen bed, overhead hatch and portholes on each side for cross ventilation.

A spacious private ensuite head with shower, hanging lockers and flat screen TV.

The aft Guest Cabin doubles as a comfortable second movie viewing area with its own TV/DVD combo. The "L" shaped settee turns into a queen bed and becomes private with the sliding curtain.

A second comfortable guest head with shower is on the starboard side, just aft of the galley, and forward of the aft cabin.

The spacious salon with a settee that sits 4 adults, also converts to a queen bed.

A cocktail table that rises for meals and two ottomans complete this salon eating area, with view of a flat screen TV within the galley cabinetry.

The Helm and Cockpit Area:

The Helm has a captain's adjustable chair with bolster cushion, and a companion seating area for two immediately to port. The perfect spot to be while cruising at about 26 knots, or top speed of 29 knots.

Moving aft to the cockpit there is a wet bar on the port side with ice-maker, and a cabinet with the generator instrumentation and fuel tank selection valves.

Back in the cockpit where we first boarded the vessel is a spacious U-shaped seating area for entertaining family and friends around the serving table. This entire surface is also the engine room hatch, which raises with the touch of a button at the helm. A fourth and removable flat screen TV is included for placing in the cockpit area.

Standing on a post it can be swiveled to your preferred viewing angle.

At the stern is an ample swim platform with swim ladder, and storage compartment for shore power cables and fenders.

## Engines / Mechanical

Twin Cummins Diesels, 6 Cylinder, 8.3 liter, 450 hp, Model 6CTA8.3-M3 - both engines have less than 1,000 hours. Engine room is under the cockpit sole.

Filters: Racor and Cummins

Cooling System: Fresh Water

Reduction Gearbox: ZF V-Drives

Propellers: 4 Blade Bronze, 22 x 25

Propeller shafts: 2" Stainless Steel

Genset: Cummins/Onan 9 kW - Zero hours (just installed)

## Galley

---

The spacious Galley is midship on the Starboard side, opposite the large settee.

At countertop level, from the left is a glass-top two burner cooktop, with a corian lid for increasing counter space when not cooking. Next is a stainless sink also with corian cover, and then a microwave with a TV above. Plenty of cabinet space allows to eliminate clutter and tuck everything away.

Under the counter-top and far left is a huge sliding storage drawer for all your pantry needs. More cabinetry for pots under the sink and then to the right a freezer and finally a fridge. It's a whole chef's area for preparing meals, plus serving space.

## Electrical System

---

Two 30 amp shore-power inlets, with two 50 ft cables and a 50 to 30 amp pigtail adapter.

Cummins/Onan 9 kW Genset with zero hours, just installed in June 2015.

Battery Charger: ProMatic 12-3, ProNautic 12-30

Hot water heater: 120 V

Electrical Panel: AC and DC circuit breakers, plus Clarion stereo and CD Changer.

Clarion stereo remote control panel at lefthand side of helm.

Fire Fighting Equipment:

Two Dry chemical portable extinguishers, plus a fixed extinguishing system in the engine compartment.

## Tankage

Diesel Tanks: Two tanks located outboard of the engines, with a total capacity of 335 gallons

Water Tank: One 100 gallon tank located under the aft cabin settee.

## Fittings and Equipment

---

Steering System: Hydraulic.

Throttle: Two independent throttles with synchronizer, on the righthand side.

Shifters: Two independent shifters on the lefthand side.

Anchor: Delta, with approximately 25 ft of chain and length of 5/8" nylon line

Anchor windlass: Lofrans Progress

Air Conditioning: Cruisair, two 16,000 and one 7,000 BTU
