Overview

Perhaps no boat in power boating history has equaled the worldwide popularity of the original deep-V - the Bertram 31. Key to the continued popularity of the Bertram 31 on the used boat market is her legendary rough water sea keeping ability and her rugged construction. The last Bertram 31 was built in 1986, yet the iconic design remains popular and many continue to be refurbished. The Double Deacon was completely restored in 2010 and re-powered with Yanmar diesels - just over 500 hours. **Engines have just been serviced.**

The boat was taken down to her bare hull and was re-wired and re-plumbed. A new fuel tank was installed and she features a fiberglass cockpit deck and a transom fish box. Further, the Double Deacon features a custom teak interior, custom flybridge with single lever controls, and a diesel generator. She has air-conditioning and heat. She was fully painted and has a half-tower and hardtop. Also, spray rails were added to her bottom and she is much drier than the traditional Bertram 31.

The Double Deacon is a must see! Save yourself time and money - buy one that has already been refurbished.

DETAILED INFORMATION

Overview

The Bertram 31 went into production in 1961. Over 2,000 31's were built in her two decades of production. The Double Deacon is a flybridge cruiser model - meaning she has the cabin bulkhead aft and a stand-up head.

Known for their large and spacious cockpit, the Double Deacon has a highly functional cabin as well. Her diesel generator provides for air-conditioning while on the water, along with other 120v systems on board.

While known for their great sea-keeping ability, the Bertram 31 also has a reputation as being a wet boat. However, the Double Deacon had spray rails added during her refurbishment and she is a much dryer Bertram 31!

Cockpit

The Double Deacon features a fiberglass cockpit deck - not the original wood deck covered in Nautilux. Further, there is a built-in transom fishbox. The 31's were known for their huge cockpit and the cushioned engine boxes make for great seating.

Head

Entry to the cabin is through a centerline door between the two engine boxes. To starboard is the enclosed head. Forward of the head is a counter with under counter refrigeration. To port is a lounge area. Forward is a V-berth.

- Recessed light overhead
- Teak framed mirror

- Stainless steel sink
- Hot and cold water pull out faucet/shower
- Floor drain
- Storage locker beneath counter
- GFCI outlet

Galley

The galley is to starboard and forward of the enclosed head. Great amenities for the day trip or longer!

- Decorative countertop
- Stainless steel sink and single lever faucet
- GFCI receptacle
- Hamilton Beach microwave - on counter
- (4) drawers under counter
- Isotherm refrigerator - dual voltage - under counter
- Recessed lighting over galley

Settee

Entering the cabin, there is an L-shaped settee to port - across from the head and galley area. The entire cabin has air-conditioning and heat.

- L-shaped settee with seat and back cushions
- (4) storage lockers underneath
- Access to storage also available beneath cushions
- (3) recessed lights overhead
- Teak/holly sole
- Access hatches to bilge area equipment

V-Berth Stateroom

All the way forward is the spacious V-berth. The berth area has air-conditioning and heat.

- Teak/holly sole - hatches to bilge space
- V-berth cushions
- Storage beneath cushions
- Carpeted side walls

- Mirrored forward bulkhead with anchor rode access
- 120v electrical panel to port
- Remote start for generator under port electrical panel
- 12v panel to starboard

- (4) recessed lights - 2 per side on separate switches
- V-berth air-conditioning and heat

Flybridge

The Double Deacon features a custom flybridge. There is a teak Murray Brothers chair and a custom aluminum half-tower with a hardtop. Single lever controls are great for backing on that monster fish or around the dock.

- Teak Murray Brother's chair with cushions/cover - stainless steel pedestal
- Custom helm pod - single lever controls
- Two step ladder off of starboard engine box to the bridge
- (5) rod holders on aft rail - gold color
- Custom aluminum frame half-tower with fiberglass hardtop
- Dome on hardtop for radar
- Recessed teaser reels in hardtop - Reel Colors
- Hardtop has recessed LED navigation lights and cockpit lights
- Custom mast light on top of hardtop
- 3-sided enclosure with u-zip panels
- Stainless steel steering wheel - tilts
- Port/starboard storage lockers - under helm
- Rupp flybridge release outriggers - double spreader
- Bilge pump control at helm - 3 pumps
- (2) drink holders
- (2) recessed lights in hardtop

Electronics

The Double Deacon had all new electronics added during her refurbishment. Great electronics package by Garmin.

Mechanical/Electrical

The Double Deacon's systems were completely redone during her refurbishment. Highlights include new Yanmar diesels, Fischer Panda diesel generator, all new wiring with new electrical panels and air-conditioning in the cabin.

Miscellaneous

During her refurbishment, the Double Deacon was stripped to her bilge. All systems were replaced and the boat is loaded with amenities for your pleasure and safety. The front windshield has been removed and is now a fiberglass enclosure. The side windows were replaced with one-piece glass panels.

- (2) Jabsco Par-Max Ultra Pumps - fresh and saltwater systems
- Engine box insulation
- High water bilge alarm
- (3) Rule 2000 bilge pumps with Rule-A-Matic Plus float switches

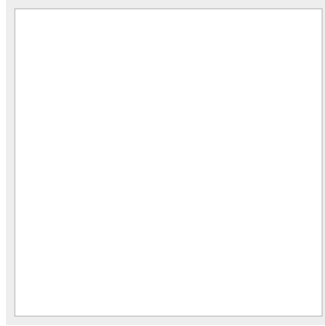
