Engines

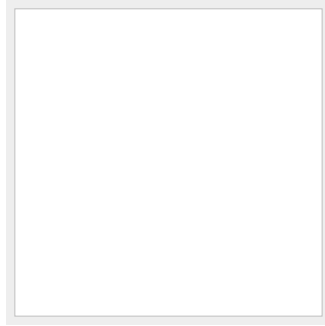
