

The exterior of the vessel was designed and built for a "no maintenance" finish with aluminum bow rail, transom door, swim platform with stainless steel ladder and no teak woodwork. The interior layout is ideal for a couple who appreciate a large salon, more than enough storage, separate built-in helm and captain's chair, a U-shaped galley below which is easily seen from the helm, separate but generous-sized berth forward, and a separate shower stall with enclosed head. The salon is spacious, bright and open. This is an exceptionally well-thought out "Downeast" Cruiser easily handled by a cruising couple. - Chain locker and separate rope locker forward.
- Forward stateroom has a full size berth with port/starboard cabinets above, 3 clothing drawers under and dry storage under berth.
- Next aft are port and starboard hanging lockers.
- Next aft to starboard is over and under storage cabinets followed by a large enclosed head with door, sink, Vacuflush freshwater head, and separate shower space.
- 35 gallon holding tank has both 12V macerator; also deck pumpout.
- Galley (port side opposite head/shower) is U-shaped with full appliances and storage.
- Galley includes white colored sink, hot and cold pressure fresh water.
- Counter top microwave.
- Nova Kool side by side refrigerator/freezer (very efficient).
- Three burner LPG stove with oven.
- Cabinets with shelves above countertops.
- Up three steps and you are in the salon.

Hull and Deck

- Hull by Atlantic Duffy, Brooklin, ME; finished by Cape Island Boats in Brewster, MA.
- Solid fiberglass hull with glassed-in stringers; Vinylester resin on bottom.

- Light Blue hull, white deck and superstructure, Blue bottom.
- Dual helms; to starboard in salon, and centerline on flybridge.
- White fiberglass swim platform with stainless steel ladder.
- Transom door.
- Bow rail.
- Windlass 12 volt
- Tinted pilothouse windows with starboard side pilot house sliding door.
- One port, starboard, aft, forward windshield windows open with screen.
- Two large cockpit storage hatches/lazarette with approximately 7'+ long aft cockpit.
- Storage locker in deck of salon.
- Two 20 lb propane tanks in a USCG propane locker on aft cockpit deck
- Fiberglass bowsprit with roller.
- Polished S/S deck hardware.
- 4 Cockpit rod holders.
- Fresh and salt water washdown in cockpit.
- Hardtop extends approximately 3' aft from cabin door.
- Stainless Steel ladder to Flybridge from aft cockpit port side
- Large Bomar hatch over forward stateroom, smaller Bomar hatch over galley and head/shower.
- 3 windshield windows, center opens.
- 1 AFI windshield wiper on Captains side.
- White PVC spray rails and quarter guard rails.
- 45lb CQR Anchor
- 2 Danforth Anchors

- Salon deck is covered with gray carpeting
- Four (4) deck access hatches for engine, fuel filters and storage
