Salon & Lower Helm

Salon:

Just forward of the large aft deck through double Diamond Sea Glaze doors is a beautifully decorated and warm salon. The salon of "Akeeva" has been thoroughly refinished and boasts new upholstery/soft goods. All windows and doors have been replaced with high end units custom built by Diamond Sea Glaze.

Galley & Mechanical space

Forward and down 6 steps is the large, thoroughly updated galley. The large countertops give ample room for preparation for gourmet meals or simple snacks. There is plenty of storage so that everything can have its place. Attention to detail is evident in the door pulls and decor which has to look and feel or the Hatteras original interior.

The aft bulkhead of the galley has many of the system controls for the yacht including the Inverter, Generator, and stereo. They have smartly located electrical distribution panel here as well. Just below the galley is the mechanical space which houses the generator, battery banks, and sanitation system.

The master stateroom is located aft below the salon and has access aft from the galley. It is easily the most quiet and relaxing area on the yacht. The head is to starboard and has plenty of light and ventilation.

VIP Stateroom

The VIP stateroom is located forward of the master and behind the engine room to the port side of the vessel. The companion way shuts off to give private access to the guest head.

Guest Stateroom and day head:

Deck & Flybrige

The exterior of "Akeeva" is incredible. With her new paint and attention to the smallest of details, she shows like a new yacht in almost all respects. Her bow sprit, swim step, and flybridge all are

customized to make this yacht stand out way beyond any other comparable Hatteras Motoryacht.

Fore/Main Deck:

The foredeck has is plenty of room for handling the ground tackle. The Main deck moving aft has wide covered walk arounds with tall teak handrails.

- Custom bow sprit fiberglassed and finished to hull
- Ideal 32-volt anchor windlass with wired, handheld remote (2006)
- Vulcan Self-launching 88 lb. anchor
- 300' ft., 3/8" high-test chain
- Fortress FX-37 spare anchor

Aft Deck and swim step:

Through tight fitting side doors at the aft side-deck is the aft deck which has plenty of room for her heavily built teak table and chairs. Look up and you will notice another detail of the overhead as it has been finished with a smooth gloss Sterling paint. Further aft, the extended swimstep is fiberglass and is custom built into the hull.

The flybridge is huge and has a rigid aluminum Bimini top with high end Stamoid canvas cover. There is a heavy duty davit to easily launch the tender. Decks and all surfaces show as new.

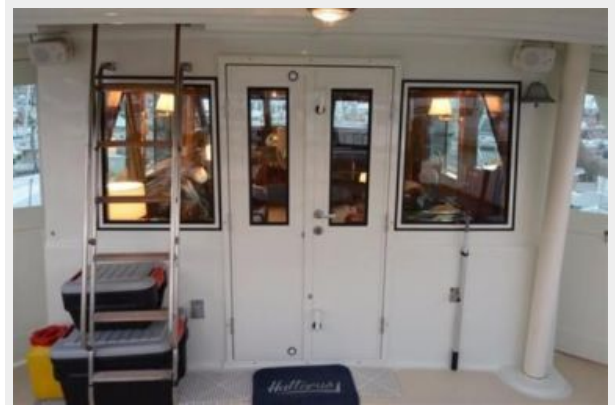
