The plumb bow carries you safely and easily through rough seas as others run for port. The reverse transom is stunning! You can easily slip away for evenings, long weekends, and extended cruises year-round.

The TN33 is designed to enhance your enjoyment as you spend time on the water with family and friends. The galley's up to keep the hosts in the middle of the party. The 33 can be single handed with excellent pilothouse visibility, easy access to the docks or the water with her wide, single level decks, and super-efficient Yanmar single diesel coupled with a high-powered bow thruster that makes in-port maneuverability a breeze.

Her transom doors open wide and the roomy cockpit becomes a spectacular private beach. The retractable swim ladder deploys from the water after your refreshing morning swim. The cockpit transitions into an alfresco dining space to make breakfast, lunch, or dinner a snap. True North's unique hull design provides a stable cockpit and wide side-decks allowing you to move around safely, whether going forward to relax on the bow, or to retrieve stand up paddle boards or kayaks from the top of the pilothouse.

The appointed layouts below are highlighted by beautifully finished cherry trim. The forward master stateroom and private, enclosed head with shower provides room to get out of the elements or spend a weekend at anchor on your own private island!

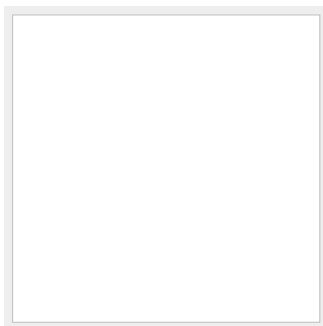

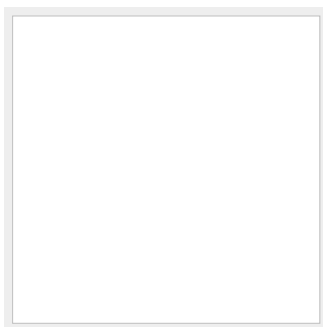

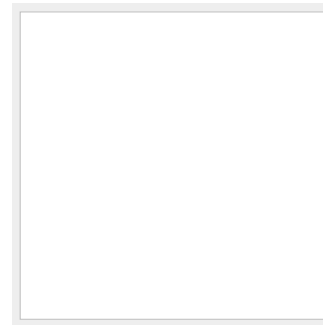

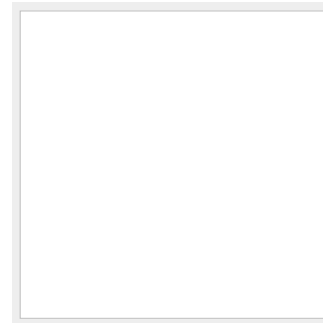
