Built for an existing owner, she was originally commissioned with a view to entering the Oyster Yacht Charter programme conforming to the MCA charter regulations, and equipped to the highest standards to offer the ultimate luxury charter experience. Whilst Blue Jeannie enjoyed a successful charter programme in her first year, the owner then chose to return her to private use, and based her in the eastern Mediterranean, where she has been lightly used for the last three seasons. Blue Jeannie is superbly equipped, and features all the comforts one would expect from a yacht of this calibre. Her specification includes air conditioning, water maker, fridge freezer, state of the art entertainment systems, as well as a wealth of other features which enable the owner and guests to relax and enjoy everything this luxurious yacht has to offer. The 625 was the first Oyster design to feature the vertical hull ports, or 'seascape' windows to the saloon, which, when combined with her sweeping 'g5' deck saloon windows, and Blue Jeannie's contemporary light maple interior joinery, make for a wonderful light and airy space below. Above decks, Blue Jeannie has a stunning spacious cockpit with twin wheels. The sloop rig features hydraulic in mast furling with powered headsail furling, allow her be sailed short-handed, yet still provide the keenest of sailors with an exhilarating ride. Blue Jeannie has been well maintained throughout her life, and the owner is now looking to downsize to a smaller Oyster.

## Specification

---

### HULL NUMBER

Oyster 625/01.

### HULL CONSTRUCTION

Above the waterline: custom laminate material comprising a combination of E-Glass, Kevlar and Carbon Fiber which offers significant weight savings, strength and stiffness advantages. Topside laminate incorporates a high-tech, foam-cored, E-Glass/Carbon sandwich above the waterline, applied by vacuum bagging techniques.

Below the waterline: single skin composite laminate, with an Aramid/Kevlar layer, reinforced with a matrix of stringers and floors. Built to comply with the requirements stipulated in the European Union's Recreational Craft Directive (EURCD) to meet design Category A – 'Ocean'.

### HULL FINISH

White hull with cove line and double boot top lines in standard Oyster blue.

### DECK CONSTRUCTION

Moulded in GRP with balsa core.

### DECK FINISH

Teak laid decks, low profile 'rolled edge' bulwark.

### KEEL

Standard keel – GRP moulded stub with lead ballast bolted to it

### RUDDER

Fully protected skeg-hung rudder.

## STERN DESIGN

'Sugar scoop' stern design incorporates a recessed platform, which is especially useful for bathing and boarding and is trimmed with laid teak. This area includes a fold-down stainless steel bathing/boarding ladder with oval treads. The platform is accessed via an integral stairway from the aft deck.

## EURCD

Built to comply with the requirements for Category A – Ocean.

## CHARTER CODING

Built to MCA Category with all associated safety equipment fitted.

## ANCHOR

Main anchor 74lb (34kg) + 325' (100m) of 1/2" (12mm) galvanized chain. Kedge anchor Spade 55lb (25kg) stowed in lazarette with 100m of 18mm Octoplait nylon warp and 10m x 12 12mm chain tail.

## WINDLASS

Lewmar V6, 24V windlass with remote control at cockpit steering pedestal

## DECK ACCESS

Midship gateway stanchions with stainless steel hinged boarding ladders, which close up to form the side-gates.

Gate to pushpit.

Stainless steel bathing ladder with oval treads.

Exit Engineering passerelle.

## HATCHES

Oyster custom drop-down washboard system for main companionway

Solimar flush hatches to foredeck, over forward cabins and heads.

2 x Solimar flush hatches with lens on aft deck over aft cabin.

Solimar flush hatch to lazarette.

Gebo alloy-framed coaming portlights.

## **CANVASWORK**

Fold down companionway sprayhood in Sunbrella 'Dune' with roll-up central window and leather covered stainless steel grabrail.

Bimini in Sunbrella 'Dune' with Velcro covers to clear viewing panels at helm and boom light, along with zipped drop-down side net panels for further shade and protection.

Cover for cockpit table in Sunbrella 'Dune' with mesh pockets.

Saloon table cover in headlining vinyl, made for closed position.

Pedestals tops and steering wheel covers in Sunbrella 'Dune'.

Cockpit and foredeck cushions in Sunbrella fabric.

Laminated cockpit seat backrests.

Crew covers to saloon seating and crew covers in Sunbrella to companionway steps with non-slip panels.

Over davit cover in Sunbrella 'Dune' for dinghy with large U-shaped zip for access/stowage at sea.

## **DECK PLUMBING**

Hot and cold freshwater deck shower in transom step locker.

ParMax 4 pump high pressure freshwater deck wash with a bayonet connection at aft transom box to allow wash down at aft deck plus freshwater forward deck wash inside anchor locker.

## **COCKPIT**

Walk-through teak-laid cockpit. Stainless steel double mug holders to forward of steering

pedestals and a mug holder by both companionway stowage bins.

## **COCKPIT TABLE**

Teak gloss varnished cockpit table with stainless steel frame, folding extension leaves to all sides of table, including extra support legs on cockpit table and Frigomatic, with keel-cooler, 24V DC refrigeration unit in table.

## **STEERING**

Steering is by a Lewmar torque rod system, installed with a pair of pedestals each incorporating a 1.06m (42") diameter Mini-Maxi type stainless steel wheel. Leather covers to wheels.

## **DAVITS**

Cooney S300 stainless steel electric davits 300kg, includes belly bands.

## **GENERAL**

Stainless steelpulpit and pushpit.

Stainless steel fairleads.

Lazarette locker with twin stainless steel gas struts.

Liferaft stowage under pushpit seats. Hinged seating for float free release.

Exit engineering passerelle with hoisting and bracing lines, halyard and clutch

Stern quarter pushpit seats in teak and stainless steel.

Stainless steel poles on aft deck: One pole for aerials and Satcom dome and separate pole for TV sat dome.

Stainless steel chafe protector plates on capping rail.

## **GENERAL**

Ten berths in five cabins, excluding the saloon.

Interior joinery finished in maple.

Designed to be modern and co-ordinated, whilst remaining practical and durable at sea. Essential features include sculpted fiddles and grabrails, 'shadow-gap' joints between panels and Oyster custom knobs for lockers and drawers.

Cabin sole in teak 'V' grove style.

Surfaces in galley in Avonite matt finish - colour: 'Palm Desert'.

Surfaces in heads in Avonite gloss finish - colour: 'Black Ice'.

Headlining in off-white vinyl with vinyl insets – Colour: 'Corn' to saloon and galley

Upholstery – Alcantara – colour: 'Corn'.

Crew covers.

Carpet to owner's cabin.

Oceanair Skyscreens to all deck hatches (except foredeck).

Watertight bulkhead to forward crew cabin.

## SALOON

The light and airy saloon features a dining table and settee area to starboard, outboard of which is a locker and a central shelf to the hullports. To port of the main settee is a comfortable reading settee, and behind this, there is a 32" TV with a remote controlled lift bar system. Saloon table in maple with teak inlay design and fold out leaves and bottle stowage in table pedestal.

## NAVIGATION AREA

The chart area is at the aft starboard end of the saloon. All instruments flush-mounted to give the optimum viewing position. Table accommodates a half-folded Admiralty chart.

Wet locker by chart table.

## TWIN CABIN

To starboard and aft of the navigation area, with upper and lower berths. This cabin has a shared access to the aft cabin heads.

## OWNER'S STATEROOM

The aft cabin is configured with a double berth offset from the centerline to port, a comfortable settee, a large hanging locker with abundant drawer and locker space. Samsung 32" TV mounted on forward bulkhead and positioned below is a vanity desk. Full length mirror on inside aft cabin door. Own companionway hatch entrance to the aft deck, via a deck hatch and a pull-down ladder in lazarette bulkhead. 2 brick digital safe in hanging locker.

## EN SUITE HEAD/SHOWER

With PAR Quietflush freshwater toilet. Washbasin surfaces in Avonite – color 'Black Ice'.

Hansgrohe quality mixer taps and thermostatic shower controls, with matching accessories.

## AUDIO VISUAL SYSTEMS

*Blue Jeannie* is highly specified when it comes to AV with every single berth boasting its own TV screen. Each cabin is networked to the onboard Kaleidescape movie server, satellite TV and Sony Playstation. Local streaming TV possibilities in all cabins. Alpine Control unit is located in the aft starboard cabin, and each guest cabin has an independent control, except for the forepeak crew cabin.

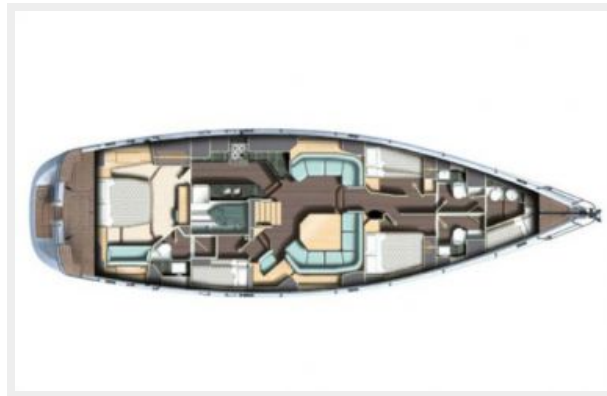
