- Glass/vinylester laminate with carbon fibre reinforcements Sandwich topsides, single skin bottom
- GRP engine bed
- Colours hull gelcoat white/stripes gelcoat dark blue 7344
- Composite mast step with movable shoe
- Stainless steel chainplate deck fittings
- Standard one design keel, templates control to tolerance 0
- Antimony alloyed lead bulb and fin with upper flange recessed into hull
- Fin bolted to hull with high tensile steel bolts. Deep floors inside
- 400 kg weight adjustment by removable lead pigs of 50 kg each inside bulb
- Foam filled rudder with carbon/epoxy stock
- Aluminium quadrant. Vectran cable steering with roller bearing sheaves
- Durepox epoxy finish below waterline sanded to 800 grit

### DECK

- Teak laid deck and cockpit floor, glued and vacuum bagged
- Sandwich with unidirectional laminates in pre-preg SPRINT and low-density foam core
- Stowage for liferaft in cockpit locker and for gas bottle in portside coaming locker
- Sliding entrance hatch garage flush with coachroof
- Hot and cold deck shower
- Aluminium 1600mm wheel with leather cover




