

2001 Hunter 380

First Impessions

This Hunter 380 appears to be a fast and capable vessel. First impressions are that of a vessel that is used for her intended purpose, as well as being a very nice looking vessel.

Walk Around

Upon stepping aboard "Always For Sail Too's" starboard side, one is met with a roomy cockpit, well laid out with plenty of stowage compartments. Here and at the stern is a pass-through gate leading down to the swim step with three large solar panels mounted on a stainless structure above. The helm pedestal is well equipped and feels to be a secure place to steer from. There are flip up tables here mounted on the steering pedestal and a "Magma" barbecue astern. All lines are led to the cockpit and one #44 Lewmar winch is powered for ease of handling. Her Isinglass is clear, affording a good view to forward. This area is well covered with a Bimini that is in good condition with seating cushions in good condition. A hangdown screen can be mounted around the perimeter of the Binini to shade the Sun.

Continuing forward and up the port side deck, one notices that the standing rigging is mounted inboard and outboard, but affording an unobstructed trip to the bow. Decks are solid all around with no soft spots noticed with secure life lines. Her mainsail is equipped with Stack-Pack and the jib is of roller furling design. The Mast is deck stepped.

On the bow "Always For Sail too" is equipped with undamaged stainless bow pulpit railing. Her ground tackle consists of two 35# "Fortress" type anchors and 200' of all chain rode and 200' of nylon rode inside a covered and lockable hatch. Here also is a winch with foot controls for anchor handling. A large bow hatch affords good ventilation.

Down the companionway and to the Salon, Immediately to port is the head with two compartments with shower and Manual "Jabsco" toilet in one and wash basin with mirror in the other. This area is reasonably roomy and not cramped. Interior of vessel is equipped with a 16,000 BTU "Marine Air" air conditioner.

Directly across and to starboard is a very well equipped "L" shaped galley that is exceptionally spacious. Here is a "Force 10" Three burner propane stove with oven. Two 11# bottles supply propane. There is an "Emerson" microwave here, a large double stainless sink and very large in counter "Adler Barbour" refrigeration with freezer section. The hatches are rigged to stay open when lifted. Storage is abundant in the Galley area.

Immediately forward is the Salon with settee's located port and starboard. Upholstery is in good condition with the dining table being slightly offset to starboard and surrounding the compression post. The port side of the dining table has a flip-up section that can reach the port side settee. There is abundant cabinetry and stowage area's behind these settee's both port and starboard.

The navigation station is located at the after end of the port settee with navigation table and all instruments mounted within easy reach.

Her forward Stateroom is large enough for two full size adults to sleep comfortably and is

equipped with a sink and hangup locker. There are plenty of stowage area's here, as well with a very attractive louvered pass through to the Salon.

On back to the Master Stateroom. Located here is a very large double berth with vanity and a hangup locker. The head can be accessed here from the port side of the space and so can the engine compartment, giving great access to the after end of the engine and shaft through hull.




