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DETAILED INFORMATION

Construction

1. CONSTRUCTION HULL NUMBER Oyster 55/02. HULL CONSTRUCTION Laid-up GRP, single skin with structural stringers and floors to Lloyds approved design specification. HULL FINISH White hull with blue trim. DECK CONSTRUCTION Moulded in GRP with balsa core. DECK FINISH Teak laid decks, perforated aluminium toerail and rubbing strake. KEEL Encapsulated lead ballast keel. RUDDER Fully protected skeg-hung rudder. STERN DESIGN Stern bathing / boarding platform trimmed with laid teak.

2. DECK LAYOUT AND EQUIPMENT ANCHOR CQR 34kg (75lb) main anchor with 60m (97') chain. CQR kedge anchor. WINDLASS Francis electric, reversible anchor windlass, remote control. DECK ACCESS Midship gateway stanchions. Gate to pushpit. Fold-down boarding ladder in stainless steel on transom. HATCHES Lewmar deck hatches x 7. Lewmar opening ports x 8. Framed deck saloon windows x 7 – forward windows open. CANVASWORK Sprayhood, 2007, in Sunbrella 'Oyster' with leather covered stainless steel grabrail to aft end. Bimini, 2007. Large sun awning. Complete winter deck covers. Cockpit cushions. DECK PLUMBING Fresh water deck shower. COCKPIT TABLE Cockpit table in teak. STEERING B & G T3-24V Hydraulic Ram steering system direct to rudder shaft. Edson wheel steering. Elk hide wheel cover. OUTBOARD BRACKET Hardwood mount fitted to rear starboard rail. GENERAL Stainlesss steel pulpit and pushpit. Lazarette locker. Liferaft, deck and lazarette lockers. Gas locker for 2 bottles.

3. RIG AND SAIL HANDLING MAST and RIGGING Rig – cutter. Keel stepped, double spreader mast with Hood (Europe) in-mast furling system. Hood telescopic solid kicker. Seaway hydraulic backstay tensioner, reconditioned 2005. Mast, boom, kicker and spinnaker poles stripped. Re-conditioned and re-sprayed by Hood, 2000. Cap shrouds replaced by Oyster, 2004. MAINSAIL FURLING Mainsail furling – Hood furling system. HEADSAIL FURLING Hood Seafurl furling headsail and staysail systems. WINCHES By Lewmar: 2 x 65 CEST electric self-tailing primaries, 2006. 1 x 48 CEST electric self-tailing mainsheet, 2006. 2 x 48 CST staysail sheet. 1 x 46 CEST electric self-tailing head and staysail furling. 1 x 44 CEST electric self-tailing mainsail furling, 2006. 2 x 16 CST travellers. 1 x 48 CST halyard on mast. 1 x 43 CST halyard on mast. SPINNAKER GEAR Twin spinnaker poles stowed vertically on mast tracks. Package includes chainplates, deck fittings, halyard, topping lift, pole lift, single sheet, guy, fore guy and all required blocks. SAILS By Dolphin, from 2009: Mainsail, yankee, staysail. By Hood: Storm staysail and radial head 1.5oz spinnaker with squeezer.

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INTERIOR

4. INTERIOR GENERAL Six berths in three cabins, two double cabins, and one twin. Interior joinery finished in teak and teak faced ply. Designed to be modern and co-ordinated, whilst remaining practical and durable at sea. Essential features include sculpted fiddles and grabrails, 'shadow-gap' joints between panels and Oyster custom knobs for lockers and drawers. Cabin sole in teak and holly. Surfaces in galley and heads in inlaid teak border/composite, coloured ivory/blue. Headlining in off-white vinyl. New Alcantara upholstery in forward cabin, matched upholstery now throughout three cabins in camel alcantara, 2009. Lee screens on sea berths. Curtains / blind system to windows in all cabins, some new in 2009. Oceanair skyscreens to all deck hatches. Flyscreens to all opening hull and coachroof ports. Electric fans in all cabins. FORECABIN With offset double berth, including new mattresses and covers (2009) and settee. Hanging wardrobe, dressing table and many drawers and lockers. TWIN CABIN To starboard with two tiered berths, including new mattresses and covers (2009), dressing table, hanging wardrobe, drawers lockers and shelves. HEADS To port with large porcelain washbasin, Sealand Vacuflush electric toilet, and separate shower stall with automatic drainage. SALOON With superb dining table to starboard, opening to seat up to 10 people and incorporating drawers and lockers within the pedestal. Three seater settee and coffee table to port. Large sideboard incorporates drinks cabinet and glass stowage. NAVIGATION AREA Adjoins saloon on port side. Full sized chart table with separate chart drawer under, and swivel armchair. Excellent fiddled stowage, drawers and bookshelves. Matt black instrument console. Sea berth built-in behind. Oilskin locker behind main companionway. GALLEY To starboard with excellent stowage in teak cupboards and drawers. SINKS Twin Franke stainless steel sinks. Electric sink drain. Stand-by fresh water and sea water pump. COOKER Taylor 041 cooker with two burners, hotplate, grill and oven with shut-off solenoid. MICROWAVE Sanyo 900W microwave oven. REFRIGERATOR Front opening fridge with Frigoboat unit and skin cooler, new compressor, 2011. FREEZER Large twin insulated top opening fridge / freezer powered by Frigoboat units and skin coolers with temperature displays, 2006. WASHER/DRYER Power and plumbing for washing machine, access via owner's stateroom shower. OWNER'S STATEROOM With centerline double berth with settees each side, dressing table, writing desk and double wardrobe. Plenty of opening ports and hatches. EN SUITE HEAD/SHOWER With Tecma toilet (electronic gear replaced in 2011), large porcelain washbasin and large separate shower compartment with seat and automatic drainage.

5. ENTERTAINMENT SOUND SYSTEM Pioneer DEH-1400R stereo CD player with 3-band radio. Speakers in saloon and owner's stateroom. OTHER No television – but sockets and digital TV Status aerial fitted.

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












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
